Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes. Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.



It has been some time since there has been some mention about the "family of parishes" here in the Archdiocese. Presently, all the parishes in the Archdiocese are now part of a family of parishes. About half of the archdiocese entered into their families in July of 2021 and the other half in July of 2022. It was last July that our family was constituted, consisting of St. Basil, St. Veronica, St.

Lucy, St. Joan of Arc and Star of the Sea. The family to the north of us is St. Margaret, St. Isaac Joques, St. Pio, Holy Innocents-St. Barnabas, and Our Lady of Hope. The family to the south of us is St. Paul on the Lake, St. Matthew, St. Ambrose, and St. Clare. These three family of parishes comprise the SERF Vicariate. (Near the back of this Bulletin you can see the listing of our family of parishes.)

The family of parishes model is a response to the pastoral situation we will find ourselves in the very near future. In 4 years, there will be about 40 less priests in the AoD and in 9 years about 90 less priests than we presently have. At the core of the family of parishes is a team of priests and ministers serving the pastoral needs of the family. Ideally there are other lay ministers or staff to help take up many of the day to day running of the parishes so the clergy can focus more on the pastoral needs of the whole family. When possible and appropriate, there might be some collaboration of programs or ministries, e.g., maybe one place for the process for adults entering the Church (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults), pre-marriage preparation, youth ministry, etc. Maybe an adjustment of weekend Mass times so not all the parishes have the same schedule.

The priests in the family are in solidum under a Moderator. While they form this team of priests in service to the whole family, they are primarily serving at one parish, as I am assigned to primarily serve here at Star of the Sea. The Moderator has some general oversight to all the parishes. Each parish still has their own Finance Council and operates independently from the other parishes. The priests ultimately form a covenant which articulates their mode of operating, the times they gather for prayer and some common fraternal activities.

Presently, our family is slowly moving along the process. We priests are working on our covenant and discussing what more can be done for what is best for our family of parishes. As you have seen, not much has changed in the operation or structure of our parish! Looking down the road, I don't anticipate any major changes at this point. Nonetheless, as we move along you will be informed of any developments!

- ** Our parish auction is just a month away! You should have received the announcement in the mail by this time. You see this year the auction will be at the Grosse Pointe War Memorial. Seeing and experiencing this new space will be exciting! Be assured the event will be great, as usual, and be a terrific source of support to the parish and the school. Don't forget the raffle and the terrific prizes being offered!
- ** I have received word that every now and then some of the parishioners are receiving those crazy emails, which do NOT come from me, asking people to buy gift cards to help me in some crazy situation. Those are a big scam! I would never do that!! If I am going to ask you for money, it will be for "raise the roof" or some project here, not anything personal! Ignore and delete the email.

Enjoy the beauty of the season...and enjoy the goodness of God's love in your life.






