#### **MARRIAGE**

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes. **Adults over 21** need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

How is your Lent going so far? We are past the half way point and soon heading into the home stretch. If you have been slipping in some of your Lenten practices, you still have time to get back on track and finish the season strong! Remember, God is always there for you. He is always there to receive what you have to offer, even if it is "late." What you have to give you might think is not much, but you know

what God can do with what we offer him with a sincere heart! He can multiple the gifts. He can strengthen what we give Him. He can fill us with so much grace, or forgiveness, or mercy, or healing, or humility after we give Him our offerings, our sacrifices, our hurts, our failures, etc. When we empty ourselves, it only gives Him the opportunity to fill us up with what we need. He knows everything and He certainly knows us.

Fr. Steven Bell has left us with many good insights about leaving our fears behind and truly living in our faith. He offered us so many practical helps in our prayer life and what it means to be Eucharistic people. We should always remind ourself how much God has done for us. How much He has provided for us when we asked for His help. Before we despair, reflect the many times the Lord has come to your aid, especially in ways we least expected it! That is why we can ask the Lord in confidence when we are in need. Remember...He hears and answers ... we just sometimes don't recognize His response! We can be deaf. We can be blind like in today's Gospel. Let us turn to the Lord God at all times and believe in His power to save us and heal us!

- \*\* Monday night from 6:30 7:30 pm I will be in church for **private confessions**. As you have read, there are some additional times for confession this Lent besides 3 pm on Saturdays.
- \*\* I invite all those who have participated in last week's Mission (and all those who did not participate in the Mission) to please come to our special **Taize prayer** Tuesday night at 7 pm. Taize is a very meditative prayer, immersed in a calming environment, that help people to have a focused prayer that is comprised of some soothing music, silence, simple prayer, and often some gesture or participation of the people focused around one object, e.g., the cross. Hundreds of thousands of people have participated in this prayer form around the world in the past few decades. Our Taize pray this Tuesday night will be a "response" or continuation of the Parish Mission of letting go of our fears and living our faith. Hope to see you there!
- \*\* Thursday night at 7:00 pm, is the information meeting for those interested in a **pilgrimage to the Holy Land.** There is information about this trip already on our parish website but our tour guide will be here Thursday for your specific questions. You don't have to commit to anything Thursday but simply come and ask your questions about this special trip to the Holy Land next spring.
- \*\* Thanks to all who have participated in our **Fish Fry** either as a diner or as a volunteer. Our season thus far has been great. We still have not reached out high point of 350 dinners like we did last year, but there is still hope we can break that record this year!





Star of the Sea students were administered the Star assessment three times during 21-22 the school year. 


