Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Congratulations to those who are receiving Jesus for the first time this weekend! It is an exciting time for these young Catholics and their family. We have seen these young ones over the recent years come up at Holy Communion time with their parents, and other family members, with their arms crossed over their hearts not being able to receive Jesus. How often I have seen them look with that desire in their eyes, waiting for the day when they can receive what their parents come to receive Sunday after Sunday after Sunday. Today is their day! They have prepared for this day for some time. One significant step along the way took place last October when they participated in the Rite of Enrollment, signifying the start of a more intense preparation and study about Jesus in the Eucharist. Their parents have assisted them through their own participation in Sunday Eucharist every week. They have studied the parts of the Mass together. They have discussed what Jesus means to them. Now this day is finally here!

Those of us who have been receiving the Body and Blood of Jesus for many years know how much we need Jesus! Yes, we need Him every week as we go about our everyday life. God, in all His Wisdom, knows us, those He created. That is why He gave us the Ten Commandments as well as the teachings of the Church...He knows what we need and these commandments and teachings guide us for our good! I was thinking about the amount of people who were at Mass for Easter (and Christmas) but not the weeks that followed. I wondered if a great number of people think and believe that those are the only days (Christmas and Easter) they have to participate in Mass! Somehow over the years maybe that is what they heard from others or just arrived at that conclusion themselves. (Maybe I should ask them!) The Commandments and teachings of the Church have not changed...we are to participate in Mass every Sunday and holy day of obligation! Why? God knows we need to have that weekly instruction through the Word of God as well as the nourishment we need in the Body and Blood of Christ! It also does our heart good to thank God each week for His amazing action in our lives!

The gospel this week is the wonderful story of the disciples encountering Jesus, though not knowing it was Jesus, as they walked along their way to Emmaus. They did not recognize him until that evening when they were at table and Jesus, repeating the actions He performed at "the last supper," the actions of taking bread, blessing it, breaking it, and giving it to them. At that moment they recognized it was Jesus but He then vanished from their sight! The encounters with Jesus at Mass are tremendous and can certainly reveal to us the many times we have encountered Jesus throughout our week. For all that we offer God great thanks every Sunday and in every Mass!

** Last week I received the happy news that Fr. Brian Meldrum had successfully "defended" his doctoral dissertation at the Catholic University of America and has been awarded a STD, a doctorate in Sacred Theology. The amazing part is that he did it in five years (when many other have taken longer)! I know though how dedicated and determined he was in this academic pursuit so this is no surprise!

Jeff Allan, come Sept. 1, will be the weekend priest support to the family of parishes that comprise St. Joseph and Christ the Redeemer parishes in Lake Orion, as well as St. John Fisher chapel university parish in Auburn Hills. He will continue to be the chaplain of Ascencion Macomb-Oakland Hospitals.

Stewardship Thoughts

In his Gospel, St. Luke, the evangelist, retells of Jesus' post-Resurrection encounter on the first day of the week with two of His disciples on the road to Emmaus. While he opens their hearts and minds to the messianic message prefiguring Christ in the Scriptures, they do not recognize the Lord until He breaks bread with them that evening. In this encounter, Jesus follows the basic structure of the Mass we celebrate today — Liturgy of the Word, a homily (Jesus' explanation of the Scriptures), and the Liturgy of the Eucharist (breaking of bread). In the Acts of the Apostles and his First Letter, Peter likewise encourages us to recognize Jesus as our Savior. As Christian stewards, where do we recognize our Lord? Faithful stewards embrace Jesus as truly present, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Eucharist, which gives us "our daily bread" and forgives our less serious sins. In addition to receiving Holy Communion, encounter our risen Lord through frequent participation in Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction.


