#### ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

#### **MARRIAGE**

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

#### **PARISH REGISTRATION**

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes. Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.



Last Saturday, Archbishop Vigneron ordained 5 men as priests for service in the Archdiocese of Detroit. It was a great day and a wonderful celebration! As you might recall, last year there was not an ordination at all! That initiated a year of prayer for priestly vocations in the Archdiocese. Since this five men were in the pipeline for the past number of years, we will have to wait a few more years to see the fruit of this past year of prayer. I am sure it

will be fruitful especially as everyone observes men they might believe would be good priests and then ask them to consider priesthood! Sometimes, it only takes one person to ask a young man to consider it to then get the ball rolling and the Holy Spirit active in the discernment. Our situation here with few ordinations are not all that bad considering other places. I heard parts of France has not had an ordination in a generation. I think only one person is being ordained this year for all of Ireland!

One of ordained is Fr. Richard Dorsch. Richard started serving as an altar boy when I was pastor at St. Thecla Parish. I could see then that a religious vocation was possible. Sure enough after some time and have working in a hospital and a few wonderful, powerful experiences, he finally responded to the calling. I was so happy to be a part of his discernment and to witness his ordination and First Mass of Thanksgiving!

One of the reasons for the Archdiocese moving forward with the Family of Parishes is the declining number of priests available for service during the next years. In eight years, the AoD can have 100 fewer priests than we have currently. So please continue to prayer for men to hear the call and respond with a shepherd's heart. Likewise, do not be afraid to ask a young man if he ever thought of being a priest. That is how many of us began our road to priesthood in Jesus Christ!

- \*\* Congratulations to all our elementary, high school, and college graduates. As we honor you today, may you be blessed and successful in achieving your future goals in life. Be strong in your faith and the living of Gospel values and principles, rooted in our faith and in our celebration of Sunday Eucharist!
- \*\* Thanks for your CSA contributions thus far. We are moving toward our assigned target. I know that as you all give, even a little gift, we will be successful in meeting our target and even exceeding it. Remember that we are also using the CSA to raise funds for our Roof. It saves us quite a few dollars approaching it this way! Beyond our target, we need and additional \$224,000 this year as we replace the lower school roof and skylights this summer. Thanks again for your extra sacrifices to meet the target and go beyond!

God's blessings on your week and the strengthening of faith through the Eucharist.

in an instructional basketball program vs CYO.


Grades K-2 intramural program \$125.00/ player. Grades 2-8 "Club" Cheerleading \$125.00/ player.




