In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.


#### **MARRIAGE**

#### IRISH PALLOTTINE FATHERS AND BROTHERS MISSION APPEAL

This weekend Fr. Brendan McCarrick S.A.C. spoke at all Masses about the missionary work of the Irish Pallottines in Tanzania, Kenya and Colombia. The second collection taken up will be to support their work of evangelization and development in those countries. Please be generous in your support of their missionary outreach.

The Pallottines were founded in Rome in 1835 by Saint Vincent Pallotti. He was a priest in the Diocese of Rome. He founded this religious community to encourage the apostolate of the laity and promote of the missionary work of the Church.

Fr. Brendan was ordained in July, 2016 for the Irish Province of the Pallottines and now serves as Associate Pastor in the Parish of St. Vincent Pallotti, Wyandotte, MI. He is also Chaplin at Henry Ford Wyandotte Hospital, and acting Mission Director.

## Our current missionary outreach (Irish Pallottine Fathers)

Our Missionary Focus for 2023 is to help and assist the Irish Pallottine Missionary Works located in East Africa. Currently our Missionary focus has three aspects to it; to feed, to educate and to provide care for the most vulnerable in society.

Farming in East Africa is dependent on water and labor. Labor is not the problem, but a shortage of water can be. A two, three or four year drought leads to localized famine and the death of crops, animals and humans. By providing community water supplies through drilling water wells we are able to sustain a local village of over 200 families through drought periods.

In addition, we also assist local communities by providing Greenhouse facilities to allow food to be grown in a controlled environment throughout the year. A \$25,000 well will provide water to a community for over 10 years, and with small maintenance costs of \$100 per year many additional years.

The Siuyu Rehabilitation Center was established by Fr Tommy Ryan, who felt there was a great need for a facility to take care of children with disabilities. The center has 4 dormitories and many volunteers to assist in keeping the center functioning.





# Stewardship Thoughts

The readings from Isaiah, Psalm 65, and St. Matthew's Gospel all reference good seed planted in fertile soil. In the expanded Gospel passage, Jesus refers to this "seed" as the Word of God. The Father showers His grace on all of humanity, but not all embrace the grace of His revealed Word and live by it. St. Paul, in his Letter to the Romans, reminds us that we have the first fruits of the Spirit. To help Catholics live by the Word, recent popes have encouraged us to read the Bible. Christian stewards who read or pray Scripture daily find real peace and joy, and develop a deep relationship with our Lord, Jesus Christ. # Saint of the Week

## Saint Mary Magdalene July 22

Though her transgressions may have been many, just as abundant was her love for her Lord.

Perhaps one of the greatest conversion stories of the New Testa-

ment, Mary Magdalene was one from whom seven demons had been expelled, a woman plagued by turmoil. She lived her own type of hell on earth, that is, until Jesus crossed her path one day. She first appears in the Bible accompanying him as he journeyed from one town to the other "preaching and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God". Her gratitude led her to follow and serve her Lord tirelessly, all the way up to the foot of the cross. She did not abandon him in the face of difficulty, nor did she deny him despite the harsh cruelty all around her. She was one of the few to accompany him, gazing upon his beaten and torn countenance as he took his final breath. Jesus rewarded this loving devotion as she is known in Mark's account to be the first one to see him after the Resurrection (Mark 16:9). May we follow the example of Saint Mary Magdalene in our unwavering dedication to God, so that at the end of our days we may also declare, "I have seen the Lord!"






