

One of the surprising movies of this summer is "Sound of Freedom." It is about a former government agent on a mission to safe individual from sex trafficking in Columbia. This powerful movie is brought to us by Angel Studios, the same that has given us "The Chosen," the very popular series about Jesus Christ. The movie has significantly highlighted and brought to our social consciousness the

great tragedy of sex trafficking in our society and the need to take every step possible to bring it to an end. Our Church has also experienced the devastation of sexual abuse, by clergy and others, raising our consciousness of such abuse and the necessity to bring that tragedy to an end.

During the past twenty plus years, the Church, especially in the United States, has created many programs and steps to create a safe environment for our children. The same is being done for older vulnerable adults, who have also unfortunately experienced abuse by those they thought were caring for them.

The past two decades, the Church, especially the Archdiocese of Detroit, has processed paid staff, along with volunteers who engage in ministry or programs with youth and the elderly, through a program generally known as "Protecting God's Children." One of the benefits of those who participated in these programs was the greater awareness to see the areas or pitfalls where abuse can happen. For the paid staff and volunteers, participating in the program, highlighted the ways to make sure, as a volunteer or staff, one does not put oneself in a position to be accused or any possible allegation. In addition, the workshops gave the greater awareness of what to watch for and see in the actions and relationships of others with children of vulnerable adults. We need to make more people aware of the sexual trafficking, "grooming," and the stages of sexual abuse. The more people are aware of the signs, the more we help bring these terrible situations to an end.

With all this in mind, the Archdiocese of Detroit wants to be part of the solution and has taken steps to bring greater protection to our children and vulnerable adults. Beginning June 1, 2023, any paid staff and all volunteers in our parishes, and associated groups, must participate in a brief live or on-line workshop and agree to follow a pastoral code of conduct to minister. All volunteers! Those who have participated in a Protecting God's Children workshop prior to 2020 must be certified to serve in our parishes.



What is the Catholic Church all about? What does it mean to be Catholic? What do Catholics actually believe?


