Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka


Our gathering every Sunday for the celebration of Mass, the great gift we have been given by Jesus Christ, is a treasure beyond price. We are doing more than simply fulfilling a Commandment or an obligation and teaching of the Church. It is the opportunity to experience this wonderful prayer, as given to us by Christ, to recall the wonderful works of God in our history and life, and then to offer to God the sacrifice of Christ as we offer ourselves. How blessed we are to then receive, as Jesus directed at his last supper, his body and blood in the reception of Holy Communion.

We are in need of more ministers to help distribute Holy Communion. It is a simple ministry yet a very important one. I know some of you have had the passing thought that this is a ministry that you could participate in. What a blessed ministry it is indeed! If you have had that “calling” then please know we will have a “training” session on Tuesday evening October 3 at 7 pm in church. Pray about it and listen to what the Lord places on your heart. Two things: one, don't be bashful to go to our prayer ministers after Mass. That is why they are there! Two, I am convinced we have other prayer warriors in our parish that can participate in this special ministry. If you enjoy praying, especially for others, please consider joining this ministry. Simply call the parish office and leave your name or approach one of the ministers after a Sunday Mass. Further discernment and training will then follow. Thank you for this consideration!

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.





In today's Scripture readings from the Book of the prophet Isaiah and St. Matthew's Gospel, God does not operate according to human expectations, and His abundant generosity is never outdone. In Isaiah, God states, For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways, says the Lord. In the Gospel, Jesus narrates a parable about heaven being like a landowner who invites laborers to his vineyard at different times, but generously pays them all equally at the end of the day. God gives us His abundant gifts to share with the poor and needy, because Jesus proclaims, the last will be first, and the first will be last. St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians reminds us that Christ will be exalted through our productive toil. As Christian stewards, we reflect our love of neighbor when we are mindful of those in need, such as by volunteering at a local soup kitchen or homeless shelter, or donating clothing and other goods to the parish St. Vincent de Paul Society.


