Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.


Star Lights Enrichment Program Thriving at Our Lady Star of the Sea School

As a Catholic school dedicated to discovering the unique potential in each child, we foster all aspects of development in a student's life. Star Lights, an after-school program launched in the fall of 2022 and produced by the PTO's Enrichment committee, builds on this vision. Inspired by Star's STREAM curriculum (Science, Technology, Religion, Engineering, Art, Math), Star Lights advances the goal of providing a complete educational experience. And, as we are one of the only local Catholic schools to offer this type of organized enrichment, Star Lights is yet another unique differentiator for our community.

Held in the fall and the spring, students meet once a week directly after school. The program explores student interests beyond traditional academics, and each class is designed and led by experts in their fields. Classes focus on the arts, life skills, and other creative pursuits.

Our current Fall session wrapped this week, and featured four classes: Jazzy Hoppers, Dinner is Served: Intro to Cooking, Art is Alive: 3D Paper Mache Super Sculptures, and Beginning Guitar. Approximately 25 percent of the student body participated in this session, and several classes had wait lists. Planning for the Spring 2023 session, which begins in February, is nearly complete, with classes to be announced prior to Christmas break.


Favorite place to travel: Bay Harbor in the summer with family.
