In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Happy Easter! Can you imagine what it must have been like to be those apostles and followers of Christ? Put yourself in their shoes. For the past couple of years you have been through all the ups and downs with this man who has been your teacher, your mentor, your friend. You have seen him sought after by thousands of people to hear him or simply to see him pass by. You have seen the crowds bow down and laud him only to have those same people yell "crucify him." Then they did. All your hope and dreams seemed lost. There was a definite darkness surrounding you. A huge void. Probably asking, "what has happened? Now what?" And then it happened. You hear the news that his tomb is empty with an angel reporting that He has been raised! What??? How can THIS be?

On Easter the great love of God for God's people is shown for once and for all. The death of Jesus was powerful but it is the light of Easter that sheds the light of truth on the Cross of Christ. This is the day that Christ has shattered the darkness of sin and death in order to bring us into the light of His truth and peace. This is the day to be renewed through the waters of baptism in our faith in the Lord and Savior. Now is the time to lift up our hearts for the great sacrifice of Jesus so that we may live forever in His love. This is Easter – the center of the Church's year and the foundation of our faith. Let us rejoice and be glad!!

Here we are two thousand years later. Maybe we are going through life still wondering about God's love for us. That would not be such an unusual thought given what we have experienced the past year. We often don't see the "signs" or feel the love coming from God. We wonder about where society is going, where the Church is going, maybe even where our own family is going? Easter is for everyone: those questioning or seeking, those who are lukewarm and those who are strong in faith. Just remember God's awesome love FOR YOU! He gave his only son, Jesus, to take on human flesh, to live like us and show us the way. He suffered and died on the cross for you and me to take away our sins and show His love for us. Then He rose from the dead, the clearest sign from God, to still show us the way to achieve eternal happiness. He loves us so much! His love is awesome!! He simply calls us to come to him, know him, listen to him, and trust in his way for us!

No matter where you are in your faith development, know one thing. God loves you, in your successes and failings. That is the bottom line of Easter. God loves you! Lift your heart. Open your spirit to Jesus and let him bring you joy and peace as you become his friend and follow him. Rejoice and be glad! This day is for you!!





Stewardship Thoughts

In the First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, St. Peter recaps Jesus' mission: to release us from the devil's grip through His good works and sacrifice on the Cross and to send us forth as His missionary disciples to preach the Good News of salvation. In St. John's Gospel, Mary Magdalene arrives first at the empty tomb on that first Easter morning. She then prompts Peter and John to go there. Scripture tells us that upon their arrival, they discover the burial wrappings. St. John *saw and believed*. This is the beloved disciple who sat at Jesus' side at the Last Supper, who bravely stood at the foot of the Cross, who, at Jesus' request, took our Blessed Mother Mary as his mother, and, through his faith, was one of the first disciples to believe in the Risen Christ. St. Paul, in his letters, illustrates how Christ has been raised up, raising us along with Him. Like St. John, may the gift of Easter grace strengthen our faith and deepen our relationship with our Lord so we, too, may boldly profess, *Jesus is risen. Alleluia!* Christ invites us to make Him personal in our lives and commissioned to spread His Good News to everyone we meet. A good place to start is at Alpha or a similar evangelization course at your parish or a neighboring parish.
