

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the procession route?

The procession will begin with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Paul on the Lake Catholic Church. The faithful will process along Lake Shore Road and conclude with Benediction at Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Church.

Where should we park?

Please park at St. Paul on the Lake. After the procession, buses will be available to take people from Our Lady Star of the Sea back to St. Paul.

Do I have to walk the whole way?

Recognizing that not everyone may be able to walk the entire route, we have a few spots where participants can join the procession.

- All are invited to the 12:00 noon Mass at St. Paul, after which we will start the procession; or meet us at 1:00 pm on the lake side lawn.
- 1:25 - 1:35 pm: the procession should be passing the corner of Moross and Lake Shore.
- 1:50 - 2:00 pm: the procession should be passing the corner of Woodland Shores and Lake Shore
- 2:10 - 2:20 pm: the procession should be passing the corner of Ballantyne and Cook Road
- Approximately 2:20 - 2:30 pm: Benediction at Our Lady Star of the Sea, followed by fellowship in the Pointe.

You can join us anywhere on the route, or join us at Our Lady Star of the Sea for Benediction and fellowship.

Will we process even if it rains?

If it rains, the Eucharistic procession will continue as planned. Please bring an umbrella or raincoat. If dangerous weather is in the forecast, please check the website for updates.






