MARRIAGE

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

This past week (July 30) we celebrated the feast day of Blessed Solanus Casey. It was only a few years ago when 70,000 people prayed at his beatification Mass in Ford Field. Having ministered much of his time in Detroit, his ministry and life is legendary. Miracles, or favors from God, have been attributed to Fr. Solanus certainly before his beatification and especially afterwards. He intercession is still

sought today by many, including the Archdiocese of Detroit itself. Archbishop Vigneron often invokes his intercession and thanks God ahead of time for blessings received just as Fr. Solanus did.

This week let us pray to God for his canonization. The Vatican has already received notification of a few "miracles" that have been attributed to Blessed Solanus. May they bear fruit and be that which is necessary to declare him a saint.

MASS INTENTIONS What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone?

An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

It is worth noting, however, that the offering of the Mass for that intention does not depend on it being publicly voiced but on it being specified in the priest's personal prayers. Similarly, if a priest announces that "I am offering this Mass for [such and such an] intention" he does not thereby require the rest of the congregation to pray for that intention.







Today, in St. John's Gospel, Jesus ties His instructions on the Eucharist to the Book of Exodus. 


