Congratulations to our second graders who participated in the Rite of Enrollment this Sunday to receive First Holy Communion in the spring of 2025. First Communion is such an exciting time for the child and the family. After many years of the young child seeing mom and dad, and siblings, go up to communion to receive Jesus and they can't, it is a BIG DAY for them to finally do what the adults have been doing. They know the process of standing in line and then finally receiving the Host from the priest or minister is special, just by observing the way others go to receive the Host, together with the prayers they see people praying before after.

Stop and think how often children want to imitate their parents. There was that tv commercial showing the little boy doing everything dad was doing, e.g., washing the car, cutting the grass, painting, napping. I see it so often when young children come up for communion and they want what mom or dad have. Remember that when it comes to the practice of the faith. Children tend to imitate what their parents do. How important that is because parents are the first teachers of the faith. When parents practice the faith through their grace before meals, prayers in the morning and evening, participating in Sunday Mass every Sunday, going to the sacrament of confession, etc., they tend to pick up those practices in their later life. When the parents fail to do that, the child will most likely follow suit until, with the Grace of God, they are formed, inspired, and encouraged to practice the faith later in life. [Studies have also shown that when the fathers especially take the lead in practicing the faith in the home, the children are more likely to do the same in their own life as adults.]

We pray for our young children who so much want to receive Jesus in Holy Communion. However their "first communion" is not something to check off a list of things to do or accomplish in life. Rather, it is only the beginning of a way of life, centered on the Eucharist, and our surrender to the Lord who gave himself in the Eucharist. We continue to pray for their parents, guardians, grandparents, and siblings who all need our prayers and encouragement to be strong witnesses in the faith. In addition, we pray for each other, to be renewed in the great gift of the Eucharist, our source of life and renewal each and every Sunday!

\*\* We are presently in a "stable transition" with our Faith Formation Program (aka "religious education"). Meredith Nesom, who has been our Faith Formation Coordinator for the past 4 years and 3 years previously as administrative assistant, has taken a different employment opportunity. We thank Meredith for her dedication and persistence to task over the years! Though leaving toward the start of the formation year, she has laid out the program for the rest of the year. Mr. Michael King, a previous Director of Religious Education or our present Mission and Vision Coordinator, will be present on Tuesdays for a smooth helpful transition while we examine our best direction forward.

### MASS INTENTIONS

#### What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone?

An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

It is worth noting, however, that the offering of the Mass for that intention does not depend on it being publicly voiced but on it being specified in the priest's personal prayers. Similarly, if a priest announces that "I am offering this Mass for [such and such an] intention" he does not thereby require the rest of the congregation to pray for that intention.

## Stewardship Thoughts

In the Readings today, Jesus professes in St. Mark's Gospel, *whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant*. The Book of the Prophet Isaiah and the Letter to the Hebrews also describe examples of Christ's humility for us to model. In other words, glory in God's Kingdom is not achieved through high status or rank, like the secular world proclaims, but through being a humble servant to all. This includes service to the poor among us. In a spirit of evangelization, expressed through stewardship, we strive to offer in thanksgiving to God our time in prayer, service, and generosity to our parish and other worthy causes. Every parish community is always in need of readers, Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, Parish Pastoral Council members, Finance Council members, Evangelization and Stewardship Committee members, and school volunteers, to name just a few ways we can serve God through the Church. 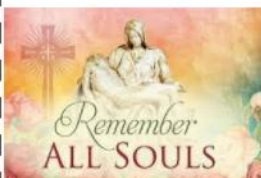

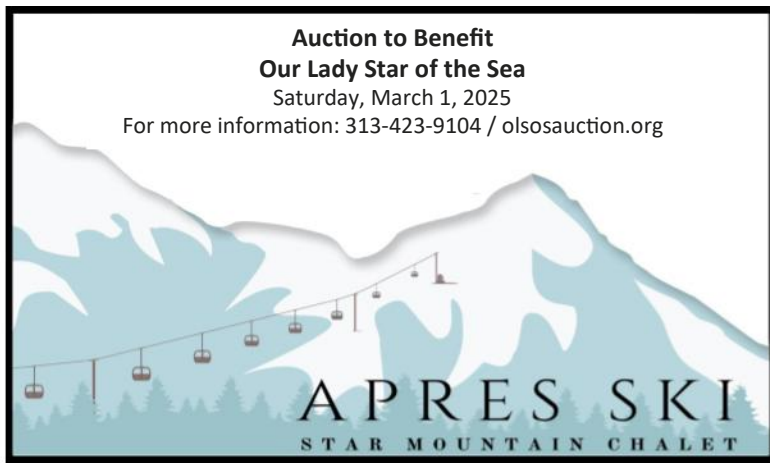
