MARRIAGE

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Happy Advent! Happy New (Liturgical) Year! There is always a lot of excitement this time of the year. There is the planning, the shopping, the baking, the different activities, and gatherings. Hopefully, in the midst of it all, we can still remember the priorities and reason of the season. Our Advent theme this year is, "When Christ enters, home begins." [This is also our focus this Tuesday at our annual Advent Family Night.]

We all know the distinction between house and home. A house is simply a place of shelter. A home is a residence, a place of permanence, a place of security, comfort, protection, and love. Home is where we are in the arms of someone who loves us and whom we love. When we let Christ in our house, He is there to provide that comfortable, secure place where love flourishes. There is a peaceful existence that permeates all we do.

Let's celebrate the season of Advent this year, even as we naturally combine and blend it with the season of Christmas, with a deliberate acknowledgement to making more room for Christ in our own hearts and then that in the lives of our family members. Advent is the time to prepare for Christmas. We see the days get shorter and the darkness of the night starts sooner. With Christmas, and the Light of Christ, the days get longer and brighter – just as the presence of Christ sheds light in our life. Even as we might put up the tree and decorations around the house, and as we light up the outside of our homes, let us be mindful of how we are preparing for the Christmas season that begins, not ends, on Dec. 25.

Another place we encounter Jesus, and invite Him to be a part of our life, is at the celebration of Holy Mass. If you have been a bit lax in participating in Sunday Mass, consider why the Church teaches us this weekly obligation. God gave us this commandment, and Jesus gave us the Eucharist at the Last Supper, because He knows us and He knows we need this weekly participation in receiving Him and, likewise, offering Jesus back to God the Father. Advent is a time for a new beginning, a new renewal, another chance to be intimately connected with Jesus. Feel like you have been missing something? Let Jesus enter, and find the best home available!

As you prepare your soul, your heart, your home this Advent, pause from the rush throughout the day and spend time being with God. See in the "things" of the season the many expressions of God's majesty and love. Experience the Sacraments and let the Grace of God flow through you!

** This first week of Advent is packed with wonderful activities. Monday night: our **Advent Holy Hour** with the Blessed Sacrament takes on a "praise and worship" style, allowing yourself to be immersed in powerful music and uplifting words for the soul Tuesday night: our **Parish Advent night** for one and all, the family of Star of the Sea. A time to be social, to pray, to listen, to sing, and then to light up our Christmas Star! Saturday morning is the **Advent Reflection** a time to pray, reflect and enjoy fellowship with others. Next Sunday, our Knights of Columbus offer their **St. Nicholas Pancake Breakfast.**





Stewardship Thoughts

As we begin this holy season of Advent, we should consider taking inventory of our lives. In today's Gospel from the evangelist St. Luke, Jesus tells of the signs associated with the end times. For faithful disciples, though, Christ reassures us: But when these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand. In other words, stand firm in your faith before the Lord when He comes again in glory and power. St. Paul reminds the Thessalonian community, and us, that our Lord strengthens us to love God and one another — to be blameless in holiness before Him. Faithful stewards acknowledge that expressing evangelization through stewardship as a way of life deepens our quest for holiness. As we prepare for Christ's birth, avoid the busyness of the "holiday season" by making time to read Scripture daily and attend Mass frequently to receive Holy Communion.


