Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

I know you are already thinking Christmas but today is still Advent! Still time to prepare, still time to open our hearts more to welcome the infant child into our midst. How much, ever more so, we need to stop, think of the Love of God in our midst, and thank God for the gift of our faith.

The legend of the Christmas tree in our homes is meant to remind us of the connection of heaven and earth as the tree points straight up with the star or angel on top and the village or nativity under the tree. Let the lights of your tree remind you of the acts of kindness needed to help transform our individual lives and the world. If you have your nativity set under the tree, lay on the floor with the children (you might need them later to help you get up!) and talk about the awe of Christ's birth and the wonder of heaven. 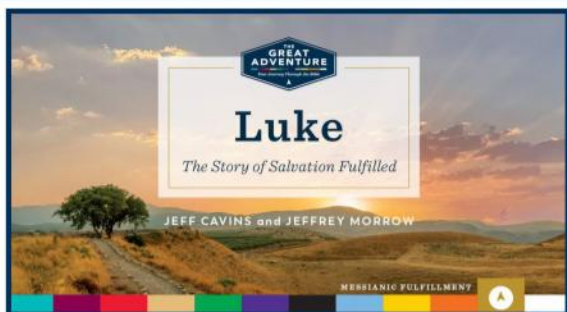

Stewardship Thoughts

In today's Scripture readings from the Book of the Prophet Micah and the Letter to the Hebrews, the sacred writers proclaim the coming of the Lord into the world. In the Gospel — the Good News — St. Luke describes Mary's visit to her cousin Elizabeth, who lives in the Judean hill country. Both women are with child. John, who as a man preaches a baptism of repentance, "leaps" in Elizabeth's womb at Mary's greeting. Even before his birth, John has a special relationship with his cousin, Jesus. In turn, Elizabeth recognizes Mary as the Mother of our Lord. During Advent, in a spirit of evangelization, Christian stewards strive for a closer bond with Christ. Use this time wisely, deepening your relationship with the Lord. Pray, read, and reflect on Scripture, and attend Mass regularly in order to partake in Holy Communion.
