## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

*Congratulations to those who are receiving Jesus for the first time this weekend!* It is an exciting time for these young Catholics and their family. We have seen these young ones over the recent years come up at Holy Communion time with their parents, and other family members, with their arms crossed over their hearts not being able to receive Jesus. How often I have seen them look at with that desire in their eyes, waiting for the day when they can receive what their parents come to receive Sunday after Sunday after Sunday. Today is their day! They have prepared for this day for some time. One significant step along the way took place last October when they participated in the Rite of Enrollment, signifying the start of a more intense preparation and study about Jesus in the Eucharist. Their parents have assisted them through their own participation in Sunday Eucharist every week. They have studied the parts of the Mass together. They have discussed what Jesus means to them. Now this day is finally here!

Those of us who have been receiving the Body and Blood of Jesus for many years know how much we need Jesus! Yes, we need Him every week as we go about our everyday life. God, in all His Wisdom, knows us, those He created. That is why He gave us the Ten Commandments as well as the teachings of the Church...He knows what we need and these commandments and teachings guide us for our good! I was thinking last weekend how empty church was for Mass compared to the previous Sunday, which was Easter. I wondered if a great number of people think and believe that those are the only days (Christmas and Easter) they have to participate in Mass! Somehow over the years maybe that is what they heard from others or just arrived at that conclusion themselves. The Commandments and teachings of the Church have not changed...we are to participate in Mass every Sunday and holy day of obligation! Why? God knows we need to have that weekly instruction through the Word of God as well as the nourishment we need in the Body and Blood of Christ! It also does our heart good to thank God each week for His amazing action in our lives!

### MASS INTENTIONS

#### *What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone?*

An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

It is worth noting, however, that the offering of the Mass for that intention does not depend on it being publicly voiced but on it being specified in the priest's personal prayers. Similarly, if a priest announces that "I am offering this Mass for [such and such an] intention" he does not thereby require the rest of the congregation to pray for that intention.

## Stewardship Thoughts

Discipleship connects today's Scripture passages. In the Acts of the Apostles, Peter and his followers bravely witness Christ to the Sanhedrin. Privileged and honored to suffer for Jesus' name, they profess: We must obey God rather than men. They are not afraid of the price of discipleship, regardless of the cost. In the Book of Revelation, the angels praise the worthiness of the Lamb with honor and glory. St. John, in his Gospel, retells Jesus' post-Resurrection questioning of Peter. Christ asks Peter three times if he loves Him — some believe that was for each time Peter denied Jesus before His Passion and death. Peter responds with "yes" each time. Our invitation to discipleship begins at Baptism. We deepen our discipleship when we accept Christ's call to a personal relationship with Him, which begins the conversion process of mind to heart — making stewardship a way of life. The power of the Holy Spirit strengthens us to proclaim Christ and follow Him.
