At his general audience on June 25, Pope Leo addressed the "fatigue of living" that is one of many issues or ailments that we face in today's society. "A very widespread ailment of our time is the fatigue of living: reality seem to us to be too complex, burdensome, difficult to face. And so we switch it off, we fall asleep, in the delusion that, upon waking, things will be different. But reality has to be faced, and together with

Jesus, we can do it well" said Pope Leo. Pope Leo was lamenting the fact that so many people of faith only skim the surface of their faith. The hearts of so many people search in other places other than their faith in Jesus as they don't really believe in the power of Jesus. Nonetheless, when we reach out to Jesus, grace still reaches us and we slowly get transformed from within. " Whenever we reach out to the Lord in faith, he in turn touches us, and his grace mysteriously changes our lives."

Pope Leo issued a challenge to all of us: "When our children are in crisis and need spiritual nourishment, do we know how to give it to them? And how can we, if we ourselves are not nourished by the Gospel?" Hopefully his words remind us to stay grounded in our faith, and the Lord Jesus, at all times and in all circumstances, not to be drawn into the blowing winds of our changing society and what "they" say is important for daily life. Most often, it only makes us busier in the less essential elements of life, separating us from Jesus but also from other members of our family. He left us with a good reminder" "In life there are moments of disappointment and discouragement, and there is also the experience of death. ...Let us go to Jesus. He can heal us, he can revive us. He is our hope!"

Fatigue of living. I think it is quite understandable as I hear from so many people how tired they are running from place to place, trying to get everything in and do everything they, somehow, think they need to do. Much of it appears that people are trying so much to make their children, and others, "happy" only to cause great fatigue, anxiety, and a sense of failure trying to accomplish an elusive goal. It is easy to push out of our daily life our faith, trust, and hope in Jesus trying desperately to accomplish other goals! Let us not be fooled! Focus on those things that keep us grounded in Jesus and our faith.

- ** I am sure many will be continuing the celebration of our Independence day this weekend. That is a good thing...just do it safely! Rest from some of the absurdities of life that is causing you "fatigue of living."
- ** A good time to rest with the Lord is during our monthly Holy Hour, the first Monday of the month!

So that is Monday at 7 pm in church.

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today, the evangelist St. Luke retells in his Gospel of Jesus appointing and sending 72 laborers into the "field" the world — to spread the message of His Good News, much like the Harvest-Master sending workers into His harvest. Our Lord states: The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. This passage is often used to encourage the faithful to prayerfully consider a vocation to the priesthood, permanent diaconate, or consecrated life. Faithful stewards are called through Baptism, as disciples, to tend the Lord's vineyard and yield good fruit. In accepting this call, we return, in gratitude, a portion of our God-given gifts to serve the Church — to unleash the Gospel.
