

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

- \*\* This Thursday is our **last outdoor Rosary** for this summer. I invite you and your family, friends and neighbors to pray the outdoor rosary (weather permitting) at 7:00 pm. Certainly bring a lawn chair or blanket for your comfort.
- \*\* Thanks to all who have contributed to the Catholic Services Appeal thus far. We as a parish, and the school likewise benefit from the work of the CSA. We have presently met our target goal so now any additional money received will directly come back to us for our use on the church roof replacement and other church-related projects.   \*\* Please pray for our staff and faculty this week especially. This week there are important faculty meetings, especially with a new principal and a few new teachers. Our parish and school office will be closed Monday for our total staff retreat. It is a great way to start "the new year."
- \*\* The parish office and school office will also be closed on Friday anticipating the Labor Day holiday!
- \*\* Please pray for Ralph Kaleniecki, the son of our music minister. (Ralph has been in our choir for the past two years and also served Masses, as well as being a sacristan.) He declared OLSOS as his parish and we are happy to support him in his discernment process! Ralph moved into Sacred Heart Major Seminary last week. He graduated from Cabrini High School this past June and was accepted into the seminary shortly after. As you can imagine, it is a huge step! Starting college is a big step, but then add on the whole seminary aspect, and it can be a bit overwhelming! Is it guaranteed that he will become a priest? No, that is a long 8 or 9 years away. Nonetheless, the seminary is the place to discern priesthood. Please keep Ralph in prayer during this journey, as well as his parents. They must adjust that Ralph is not around (though not far away). [For some reason, I get the impression Ralph's younger brother, Chuck, doesn't seem to mind!] \*\* For those who come forward with a pyx in order to take Holy Communion to someone at home or in an institution, please (you) receive Holy Communion first and then the eucharistic minister will place the host in your pyx for communion to the homebound. It is also important that you take Holy Communion directly to the homebound immediately after Mass. You should not be going to breakfast, or shopping, and then some time later get to the homebound person. Respect for Jesus in the holy eucharist demands that you go directly to the sick or homebound person.

Let us hold each other in prayer, supporting each other in our lived faith and our belief that the Eucharist we receive every Sunday changes and transforms us as Christ intends.

# Stewardship Thoughts

Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time (August 23/24, 2025) God's saving power of salvation is inclusive. After missionaries minister to the Gentile nations, the prophet Isaiah professes that even some pagan converts will be allowed into Israel's holy, priestly order of Levites. Our Second Reading, from the Letter to the Hebrews, tells us that ... whom the Lord loves, He disciplines. This is analogous to a father disciplining his children with love. In the Gospel, the evangelist St. Luke is clear, through Jesus's teaching, that eternal salvation is not guaranteed. Those who become devoted disciples, even if not first to hear the Word of God, will be first in the Kingdom; those who are first to hear His Word but do not take it seriously will be last. God the Father invites all to the heavenly banquet through the narrow gate. At our Baptism, Jesus invites us to be His disciples — a first step to eternal life. He continues to extend this invitation throughout our lives. As we deepen our relationship with Him, we strive to bring others to know Christ's love, truth, peace, and joy. Read the inspiring life story of Blessed Father Solanus Casey, a modern-day holy man who helped bring others to holiness.
