There are also a host of super volunteers who labor and give their all through a wide variety of ministries and volunteer opportunities to enhance the parish and school, bring people closer to the Lord and help build a stronger community. To the staff and all these volunteers – a very grateful thanks for all you do, and I hope that on this Labor Day God will continue to bless you and reward you for your goodness!

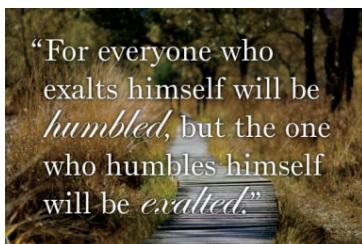

Archbishop Weisenburger joins with his brother bishops across the United States in asking the faithful to be most generous in a critical collection for the people of Gaza sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

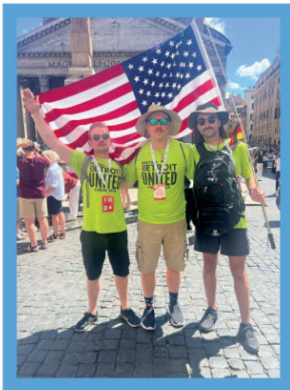

**Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time** The topic of humility is articulated in today's First Reading and St. Luke's Gospel. The Scripture passage from Sirach teaches that the humble person is loved, God-favored, and able to atone for sins through the giving of alms. In the Gospel, Jesus narrates a parable about humility to expose the arrogant Pharisees: *... everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted.* Faithful stewards humbly recognize God as the source and giver of all gifts. We exhibit true humility when we discern and find His will instead of following our own. It is in unison with God's will that we find true joy, peace, and happiness in this world. Humility occurs when we serve other's needs before our own in Corporal Works of Mercy without the expectation of repayment. These acts of stewardship — sacrificing our time, talent, and treasure for others — help build God's Kingdom here and pave the way to eternal joy.

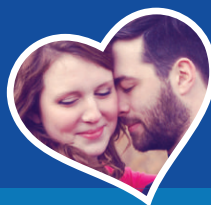
