ANointing OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office or online at OLSOS.org. Please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Who wants to be a millionaire? I think I see a few hands going up!! Of course, it is a good question and it is also the name of a fan favorite television show. As we watch the television show, we see the challenges involved. The first set of 5 questions or so are relatively easy to answer correctly. As we progress up the chain desiring more money, it does get to be more challenging. We need

a friend to help us!

Who wants to be a catholic? That question probably has fewer hands going up! Yet, it is a most important question. You probably know people in your family, or among friends, who have been thinking about becoming catholic. Maybe they have been influenced by some strong catholics in their relationships, work place, or the wider community. Sometimes individuals hear an inner calling from the Lord to either become baptized or “convert” from another denomination. Sometimes there are individuals who want to become catholic because of a pending marriage, baptism, or another sacrament of the Church. There are people who want to become catholic but don’t know how to go about it.

When you see or hear the acronym “OCIA” in print or conversation, it stands for the *Order of Christian Initiation of Adults*. (Up until the past year, it was referred to as “RCIA” or the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*. The change has come about through an honest understanding of the process, i.e., it is not a simply a rite, or ritual, to become a christian but or *order* or process of initiation, i.e., going from one phase or stage in a spiritual process that ultimately leads to baptism or reception of the sacraments of the Church. It is more than a class or a set of instructions. It is seen as a journey of faith into a deeper faith and union with Christ in the Church.

If you, or someone you know, has been thinking about becoming a member of the Catholic church, please give us a call at the parish office. The process takes a number of months, depending on one’s previous instructions in faith, no matter the denomination or not!

Stewardship Thoughts

The Exaltation of the Holy Cross (September 13/14, 2025)

The themes of today's readings are the raising and triumph of the Cross in overcoming the sins of mankind. The Divine Author in the Book of Numbers describes how the Lord punished the people who complained against God and Moses by sending deadly serpents that resulted in many deaths among the complaining people. When the people admitted their sin, the Lord instructed Moses to make a bronze serpent and mount it on a pole, so those bitten who repented could look on it and be healed. St. Paul, in his Letter to the Philippians, describes Jesus obediently humbling himself, even to death on a cross. And because Jesus followed God's will, God exalted Him so *every knee should bend, ... and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father*. In his Gospel, St. John links Moses lifting up the serpent in the desert to Jesus being lifted up on the Cross. And he reminds us God so loved the world that He gave His only Son so that by His life everyone might have eternal life. Jesus has given us the Sacrament of Reconciliation as the instrument to repent of our sins like the people in the desert.

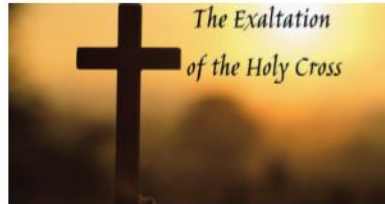

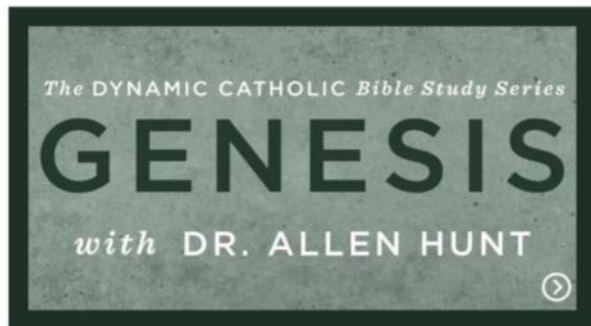


