Happy Feast Day! This weekend we celebrate the traditional feast day for *Stella Maris*, Our Lady Star of the Sea. This wonderful title of our Blessed Mother, Our Lady Star of the Sea, goes back hundreds of years, first used by St. Jerome in the late 300s. As depicted by the title, seafarers and mariners looked at the stars to help guide them in their direction. Just as those

stars in the night skies provided guidance, so too our Blessed Mother guides us to safe passage on the stormy seas of life, guiding us to Jesus.

St. John Paul II composed a beautiful prayer that reflects this understanding of our Blessed Mother's role in our life, under the Patronage of Our Lady Star of the Sea.

O Stella Maris, light of every ocean and mistress of the deep, guide [your children on earth] across all dark and stormy seas, that they may reach the haven of peace and light prepared in him who calmed the sea.

Keep all your children safe from harm for the waves are high and we are far from home.

As we set forth upon the oceans of the world, and cross the deserts of our time, show us, O Mary, the fruit of your womb, for without your Son we are lost.

Pray that we will never fail on life's journey, that in heart and mind, in word and deed, in days of turmoil and in days of calm, we will always look to Christ and say, "Who is this that even wind and sea obey him?"

O Help of Christians, protect us!

Bright Star of the Sea, guide us!

Stewardship Thoughts

Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time In today's First Reading from the Book of the Prophet Amos, he warns *the complacent in Zion* against extravagant living with no concern for their needy neighbors. In St. Luke's Gospel, the evangelist narrates Jesus' telling the parable of Lazarus and the rich man to the Pharisees. The rich man — so preoccupied with his own riches and luxury — disregards the beggar Lazarus at his door. In eternal life, Lazarus is *carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham* while the rich man has condemned himself to eternal torment. This is not due to his wealth, but because he ignored the needs of his poor neighbor, Lazarus. Jesus commands love of neighbor as the second of the great commandments. Christian stewards embrace this directive when they generously share their abundant gifts with those who are less fortunate. Donate time at a local soup kitchen as a way to exhibit your love of neighbor.

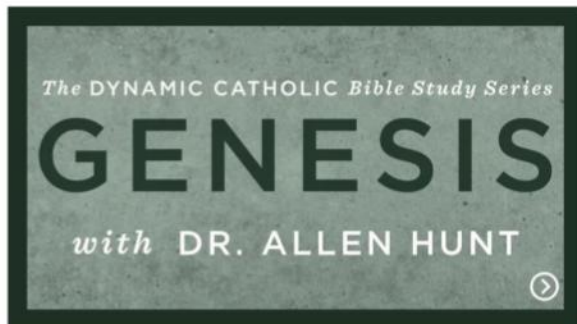

As we enter the last third of 2025 of this Jubilee Year of Hope (which ends on the Feast of the Holy Family, Dec. 28), you are invited to grow in hope and share hope with others by taking advantage of the many Jubilee Year opportunities the Church offers.

One way to grow in hope is through local pilgrimage to one of the 12 official Jubilee Year pilgrimage sites. One site is St. Joseph Chapel & the Shrine of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (400 South Blvd. West, Pontiac, MI 48341)—one of the six Marian Shrines of Michigan. WE INVITE YOU TO VISIT this little holy place. You can visit our miraculous statue of the Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary in our Shrine-Grotto (look for the small building with the blue awning) and our signature statue, Our Lady of the Cape ("Notre Dame du Cap")—the Queen of Canada and Queen of the Most Holy Rosary—in the chapel. It was through one of her traveling statues that the Blessed Mother asked the pastor in 1947 at the Marian Congress in Ottawa, Canada, to start a shrine in Pontiac.

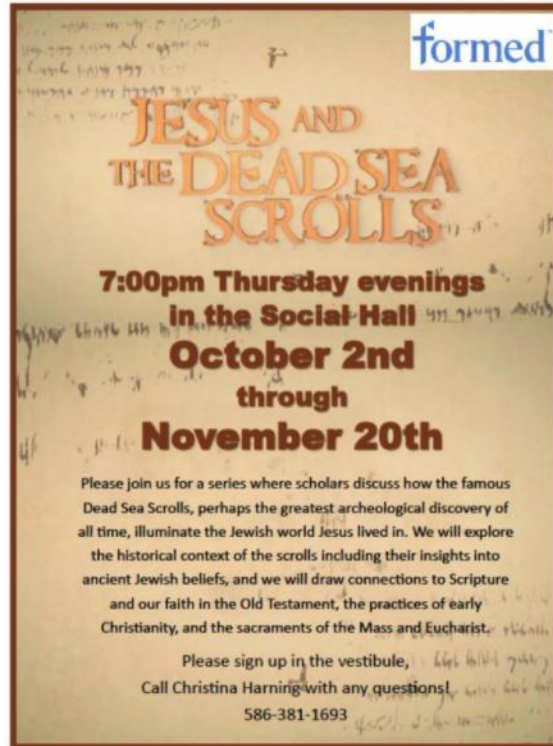
