ANointing OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office or online at OLSOS.org. Please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

I ask for your prayers this week (Sunday afternoon through Thursday) as we priests from the Archdiocese of Detroit gather together at our convocation, held every other year. It is a great time for us to be together to pray, to share our priesthood, to hear inspirational talks, engage in thoughtful reflections, and just relax with one another in the beautiful Northern Michigan. Usually when we meet throughout the year, it might be at a two or three hour meeting. Or we see some of the priests at ordinations, at the Chrism Mass, or at a funeral. Our convocations have been profitable in many ways over the years.

This year especially we gather with our new Archbishop, Edward Weisenburger. In the short 6 months he has been here, he certainly has gotten around the archdiocese, as evident in the daily postings on Detroit Catholic. He has engaged the priests in 17 listening sessions in his first four months and has already enacted on some of the suggestions that were offered. I have had the pleasure of meeting him personally a few times and find him a delight to be with, easy to engage in conversation, and a man spiritually rich and not afraid to defend the faith. (I also find his weekly "homily" on the Sunday readings to be clear and very worthwhile.). It will be good for all of us to be with him, especially in a more casual atmosphere.

Our liturgies of morning and evening prayer, daily time for adoration, and of course celebration of the Eucharist is always very up-lifting. A special liturgy we have is praying for and remembering all the priests who have died since our last convocation two years ago. Also sobering to know your own name will be pronounced one day! ** We have no morning Masses this week, Monday through Thursday. Please see in this paper Mass times at some neighboring parishes.

** Please consider if you are being called to one of our liturgical ministries. That could be exercising a special charism God has gifted you, like love of scripture and a good voice to proclaim the readings at Mass as a lector. Or being an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion at Mass. Or an usher to greet people and assist people as needed. Or sacristan who prepares a few items (chalice, lighting altar candles, hosts, etc.) before Mass begins and helps after Mass. Or you can help wash and iron our sacred linens periodically once a month or so. Or help with "the environment" as needed through the year, helping to "decorate" church and in the sanctuary, etc. Please pray on this request as most of these ministries do not demand lots of time each week or each month. In a few weeks I'll ask again for those interested or just all the office for more information or to express your interest. We provide the education for formation you need to exercise the ministry. That also includes our "prayer ministers" who make themselves available after some Masses. Finally, our music ministry is always open for new members, either singing or playing an instrument, for a special season, like Christmas, or for the liturgical year. The ministries are another way to encounter the Lord in our weekly celebrations as the body of the Church.

** We will be taking "head counts" during the next 6 weeks at Mass. These counts will be used in future planning within our parish and the archdiocese.

** During the 9:30 Mass the next two Sundays we will celebrate the rite of enrollment for those intending to receive their First Holy Communion and the Sacrament of Confirmation. Please pray for these young people, and their parents, as they prepare during these important "sacramental years."

Know the Lord's love for you and pray for one another.

Stewardship Thoughts

In today's Scripture readings in the Second Book of Kings and St. Luke's Gospel, we hear of the miraculous curing of those who have contracted leprosy. In Kings, Naaman is encouraged to seek out the prophet Elisha to cure his disease. After much uncertainty, he follows Elisha's counsel and is healed. In gratitude, Naaman constructs an altar in his homeland to *no longer offer holocaust or sacrifice to any other god except to the Lord*. In the Gospel of St. Luke, the evangelist narrates the account of the 10 lepers who encounter Jesus en route to Jerusalem and are healed. Yet only one, a Samaritan, returns in gratitude to thank Jesus. As stewards on a faith journey, do we remember to thank our Lord for His abundant blessings, or do we take our gifts for granted? Have we adopted an "attitude of gratitude?" Thank the Lord daily for at least five blessings received.

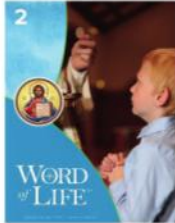
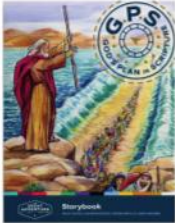

THIS YEAR IN FAITH FORMATION!

This year, over 100 students are growing in faith together through our Faith Formation program! We are blessed to have 16 eighth graders and 8 seventh graders preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation, and 23 second graders preparing for their First Reconciliation and First Communion.



Each grade is exploring the beauty of our Catholic faith through a variety of engaging programs:

- **1st Grade** – Using God's Plan in Scripture, students are beginning their sacrament preparation by learning foundational prayers.
- **2nd Grade** – Using Word of Life, students are preparing for their sacraments and have received personal Mass booklets to help them learn the parts of the Mass.
- **3rd-5th Grade** – Continuing with Word of Life as they deepen their understanding of faith and discipleship.
- **6th Grade** – Studying God's Plan in Scripture and receiving their own Bibles, which they'll personalize with handmade covers.
- **7th Grade** – Beginning their Confirmation journey through Alpha and Chosen.
- **8th Grade** – Continuing with Chosen and Confirmed in the Spirit as they prepare to complete their Sacraments of Initiation.

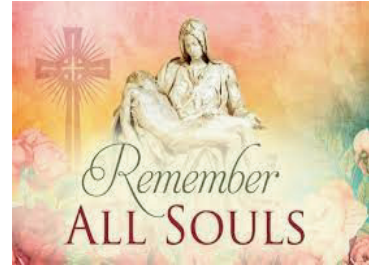
Operation Christmas Child
