The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office or online at OLSOS.org. Please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.



Happy Advent! Happy New (Liturgical) Year! I hope that your Thanksgiving Day was a time of humble gratitude of all that the Lord has bestowed upon you. Having such a disposition opens our heart by the simple fact of acknowledging we have been blessed in so many ways. When we open our heart, we see even more so what the Lord is

doing in our life!

When we open our heart and our mind, it is easier to prepare. It seems we are always preparing for something as we prepare for school, our jobs or ministries, our vacations, moving into a new home, etc. As we anticipate Christmas, there is a lot of preparations going one. You prepare for gift giving, for decorating the inside and outside of the house, for family gatherings, etc.

Advent is the time to prepare for Christmas. We see the days get shorter and the darkness of the night starts sooner. As you prepare your soul, your heart, your home this Advent, pause from the rush throughout the day and spend time being with God. See in the "things" of the season the many expressions of God's majesty and love. Experience the Sacraments and let the Grace of God flow through you!

MASS INTENTIONS

What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone?

An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

It is worth noting, however, that the offering of the Mass for that intention does not depend on it being publicly voiced but on it being specified in the priest's personal prayers. Similarly, if a priest announces that "I am offering this Mass for [such and such an] intention" he does not thereby require the rest of the congregation to pray for that intention.
