The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office or online at OLSOS.org. Please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

We are now in the final ten days of the Advent season. The days of Christmas will be here soon. Even in these sometimes challenging and certainly hectic times, we have probably done much during these past weeks to prepare for Christmas through our decorating, shopping, baking, cooking and much more. Now more than ever is the time

to focus on Jesus and the joy that we should have as the Word of God becomes flesh for us.

There are many little ways in which we can certainly keep the focus of Christ in this last half of the Advent season. For instance, if you have some gifts to wrap, say a little prayer for the person who will receive the gift. Think about their good qualities and characteristics. Think of little ways you might continue to help them throughout the year. Maybe a note or phone call every now and then. As you might receive gifts from others and place them under your tree, thank God for the gift of these people in your life. How in some way have they brought you closer to Jesus? How do they challenge you through their lives to be a bit more Christ-like in yours?

Our theme this Advent has been, "Prepare Him Room." Think of all the things you do around your house when you have to prepare a room for an incoming guest. We do all those things because we want the guest to come and feel they are a part of our family, ourself. Do we often restrict Jesus from coming into our life, our heart? When we prepare a special place for Jesus, he enters with peace, gentleness, and companionship because he feel welcome in our home, in our space. Isn't that how you feel when you are warmly invited into someone's house as a guest?. There is a comfort when we know Christ is present. That fact gives us true deep joy and peace, especially when being challenged by life's issues.

- ** Invite others to join us here at Star for our Christmas liturgies. It is wonderful to see so many people who are friends or family of parishioners. Patience, consideration and hospitality are always good virtues to practice, especially as so many gather to celebrate these holy days. (Remember we no longer have the 4:15 overflow Mass.)
- ** Remember to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation (confession) this Advent. This is another important way to let Christ enter deeper into your heart and bask in the forgiveness and mercy he bestows upon us, the reason why he came to save us. This week I have added two afternoon times (2 -3 pm on Tuesday and 1-2 pm on Thursday) plus an evening (6:30-7:30 pm on Monday) for individual confession. May you be touched by the powerful presence of the Lord as we prepare and celebrate His coming!
- *. If you play a musical instrument and would like to share your talent in our liturgies, please see, talk, or contact Aaron. He is always happy to engage other musicians in our liturgies!

May your Advent journey continue to bring you surprises from the Lord and a closeness only He can give!
