## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

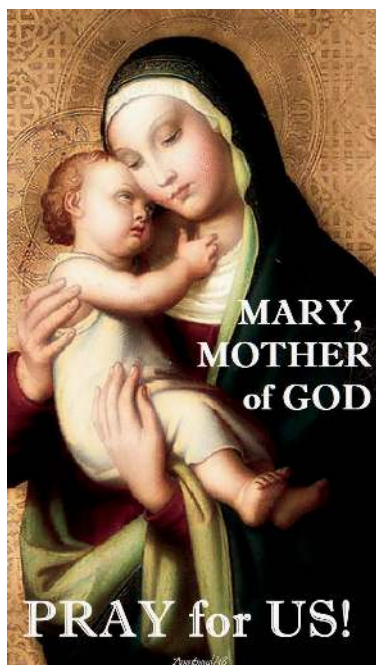

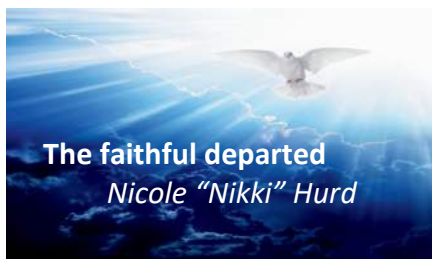

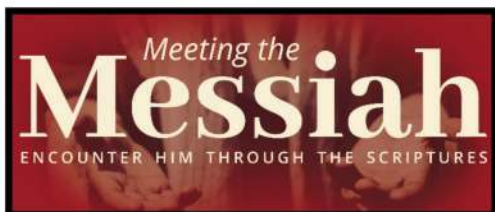
