## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

### Happy Epiphany!

Our celebration of the Magi coming to see the newborn King should also remind us of our own need to come before the Lord to offer homage and praise. We each come before the Lord with the many gifts God has bestowed upon us. We might not have gold, frankincense

and myrrh, but we have faith, a free will, and the love of God. We might also have a sense of humor, intelligence, compassion, a listening ear and heart, insight, wisdom, physical skills, athletic skills, musical ability, etc., etc., etc.. We all have many God given gifts that we first must offer thanks to God and then use in the service of others for the sake and good of others.

There is a custom of blessing homes on this day or during this week of Epiphany. Over your door frame, in chalk, you would put 20 + C + M + B + 26. This is the new year we are in with the first initials of the three traditional names of the three kings, Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar.

I pray that during this year we will continue to grow in our love of all people as sisters and brothers in the Lord. May this year bring all of us closer to the Lord and to each other. There are so many gifts from God that still need to be discovered and used for the sake of the Kingdom of God. May the Light of Christ continue to shine bright in the hearts of all Our Lady Star of the Sea Parishioners as we journey together to the Kingdom.

\*\* This Tuesday, in Rome, the Jubilee Year of Hope officially comes to an end with the closing of the Holy Door. While the year comes to a close, let us remember what is essential in our belief: "Hope does not disappoint" (Rom 5:5). As Pope Francis wrote in the declaration about the Jubilee Year of Hope, *"Everyone knows what it is to hope. In the heart of each person, hope dwells as the desire and expectation of good things to come, despite our not knowing what the future may bring. Even so, uncertainty about the future may at times give rise to conflicting feelings, ranging from confident trust to apprehensiveness, from serenity to anxiety, from firm conviction to hesitation and doubt. Often we come across people who are discouraged, pessimistic and cynical about the future, as if nothing could possibly bring them happiness. For all of us, may the Jubilee be an opportunity to be renewed in hope. God's word helps us find reasons for that hope. ... (1).*






