ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office or online at OLSOS.org. Please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

This coming Wednesday, February 11, is the Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes. On this day we recall a series of 18 appearances that the Blessed Virgin Mary made to a 14-year-old French peasant girl, Saint Bernadette Soubirous. It was there at Lourdes that Our Lady said, "I am the Immaculate Conception." Our Lady instructed Bernadette to dig in the ground nearby, from which came a spring with healing properties, active to this day. In more than 150 years of thousands of pilgrims visiting the grotto at Lourdes each year, 70 miracles have been officially declared, after very thorough investigations, from the intervention of God through the intercession of Our Lady of Lourdes. Hundreds and hundreds of other miracles have taken place not officially declared by the Church.

Lourdes, in the southern part of France, has always been a pilgrimage destination for those who are sick, for people who need healing. Naturally, we think of people who have physical sickness or infirmities, e.g., cancer, terrible arthritis, unforgiving back pain, tumors, etc. However, people also go there for spiritual and psychological healing.

I know from my time there that there is much more healing taking place through the Sacrament of Reconciliation than through the "bath" waters as Our Lady had directed. People leave healed psychologically and spiritually. They praise God for the new life and blessings in their life.

Back in 1992, Saint Pope John Paul II declared Feb. 11 as the World Day of the Sick. It is a day to pray for the sick and all their caregivers. The theme this year is [The compassion of the Samaritan: Loving by bearing the pain of others.](#) On this special feast day, please pray for all those who need God's special healing. It could be physical. It can certainly be spiritual. You know people who need healing, place them before the Lord through the intercession of Our Lady of Lourdes. Please also remember to pray for those special care givers! May the Lord give them patience, strength, encouragement, and the tenderness of Christ's heart!

Beginning this Wednesday, priests can begin using a new ritual, "The Order of the Anointing of the Sick and of their Pastoral Care." It does not contain anything radically new. The anointing is done the same, with the same words. It does give us another opportunity to understanding this wonderful sacrament of the anointing of the sick. Here is the first thing to know and remember: You can be anointed many times! Before a surgery, at the start of an illness, as it progresses, and certainly as death might be imminent. The second thing to remember, do not wait until the last day or last hour to then find a priest to come and do the anointing!! You might not find a priest able to come immediately for various reasons. As soon as one progresses in their illness and enters hospice, that is a good time to call. Third, there is not something different called *extreme unction* or "last rites." The anointing is the same. (If a person was anointed recently, there is no expiration date on the anointing.) Fourth, the person must be living to receive the sacrament of the sick. We do not anoint a body after death.

It is a wonderful sacrament, and it certainly provides comfort and peace to the sick person as well as to their family.






Hope Rises in Christ.
