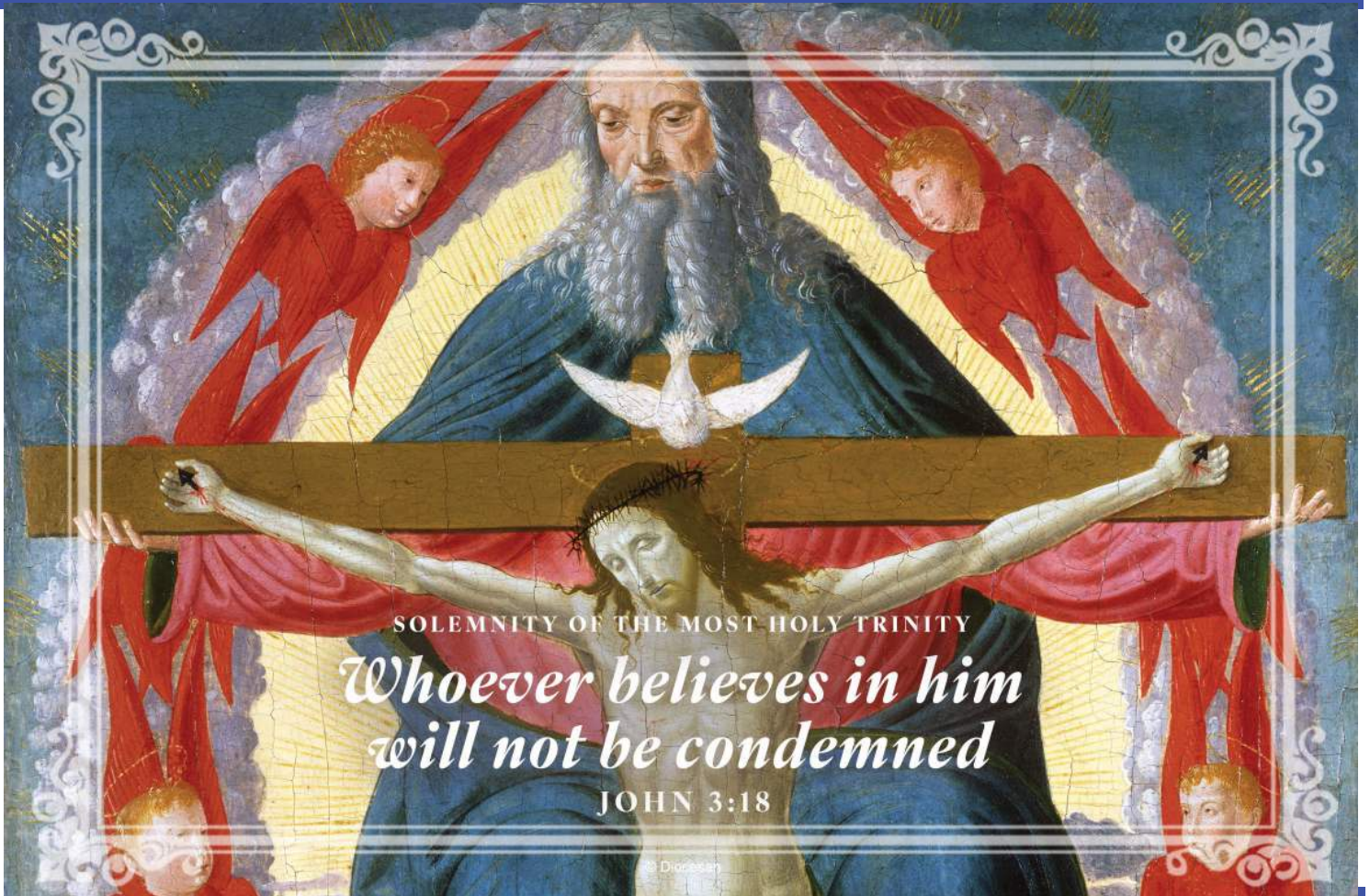

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

**Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS, for at least 3 months before prep can begin.**

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

This coming Tuesday and Thursday, Our Lady Star of the Sea Parish will have its "listening session" regarding the Archdiocesan restructuring process. These sessions will begin at 7 pm. When you arrive, it will be posted if they are taking place in church or in The Pointe.

These sessions are an important part of the process. The process started this past January when the priests gathered for three days at the seminary. We all knew something needed to be done but how can it best be done? The archdiocese was divided into 15 planning areas. For us, it took the shape of our present vicariate.

Why do we need this restructuring? The hard facts prove the need. In ten years, we will have approximately 100 fewer priests. In five years, 40-50 fewer priests. With more than 200 present parishes, staffing them as we do now is not the solution. We also see now in the archdiocese we have more funerals than baptisms. We have fewer Catholics participating in weekly Sunday Mass, like 40% fewer. There is also \$94 million dollars of deferred maintenance for our buildings throughout the archdiocese. Most of our churches are generally only filled 30% with our present Mass scheduling. In order to have vibrant parishes, flourishing priests, and being mission focused and ready, change needs to come. It is not just Detroit. More than 30 dioceses have gone through a similar process with more to come.

All parishioners are invited to participate in one of the sessions. What is important is to *listen first* to the facts and understand the situation. Then, as the various models of pastorates are proposed for this planning area, comments will be solicited.

What is a pastorate? It will be a grouping of parishes, with a number of priests assigned, under one pastor in charge. Given that priests are allowed to preside at two Masses a weekend, there will be only a limited number of Masses allowed in a pastorate. This will fill our churches more to capacity and hopefully more vibrant liturgies.

Everyone will be effected in this restructuring. Some existing parishes will not be able to have a weekly Sunday Mass. Most parishes will see a reduction of weekend Masses. New pastors will be assigned to the pastorates.

The facts and data for Our Lady Star of the Sea can be found in the parish workbook. The workbook is available on our website or at this link, <https://aod.filecamp.com/s/i/UV6KQhipu6szhyHb>. We strongly encourage everyone to review the information before attending the sessions.

Please remember that these sessions are focused on the future planning of this vicariate. They are intended to provide an opportunity for participants to learn about the proposed models and share feedback on those models. All comments will be documented and submitted to the archdiocese for review.

These sessions are not intended to be a forum for complaints about the Church or unrelated topics.

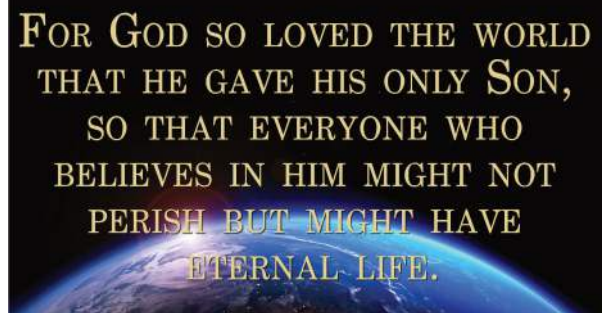

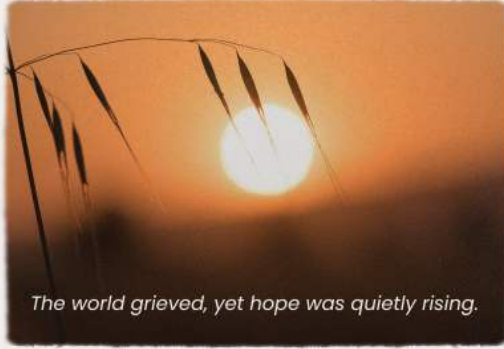

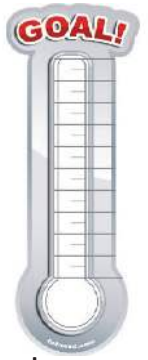
God has blessed each of us with time, talents, and resources meant not to be held back, but shared generously. Through faithful stewardship, we participate directly in the Church’s work of evangelization.

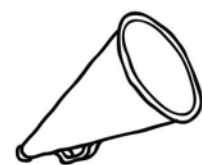
