**Bride or Groom must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS, for at least 3 months before prep can begin. Bride or Groom need to contact the parish to inquire about wedding prep.** Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months prior to your wedding date to start preparations.

## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Even though we are moving into the bit slower "summer" mode, there are still several important items to be attentive to!

This is the time when major work happens around campus. Thank goodness we are done with roofs! (Thanks to you for your generosity!) In the church, you will see new carpeting under the pews. I know some people thought it wasn't needed but in many areas of the church the carpet had lost its texture and was pretty worn down and stained! During the first two weeks of July, new upholstery will go on the pews along with new and improved padding and upholstery on the kneelers. Then in the autumn, work needs to be done on the organ to keep it in fine shape for the next 25 years.

The school always has work done during the summer. We are finally getting to the last remaining classrooms to take out floor tiles and replace them with nice laminate flooring. Of course there is always some painting, shifting of classroom, fixing or replacing 70-year-old water and boiler pipes. Then the typical replacement of older electronics, etc. There is always something that needs to be done, changed, and improved in the school.

A big THANK YOU to the 35 people who came last Sunday afternoon to unbolt the pews and move them so the new carpeting may be installed. Many hands do make for quick and lighter work. This amazing crew of volunteers was done in 45 minutes!!! All the pews were unbolted and moved without a problem. Thank you to each and every one of you who came and helped in any way.

\*\* Thanks for your cooperation with the envelope situation. Many people think we send out the envelopes. We do not. Parishes use one of the few companies who do that. Our company has informed us that they are having problems with another company that actually supplies them with the envelopes to then print and process out to you our parishioners. They hoped to have this resolved by mid-June. In the meantime, or at any time, simply put your name and your envelope number on an envelope you have lying around the house and turn that in to us. Sorry for the inconvenience.

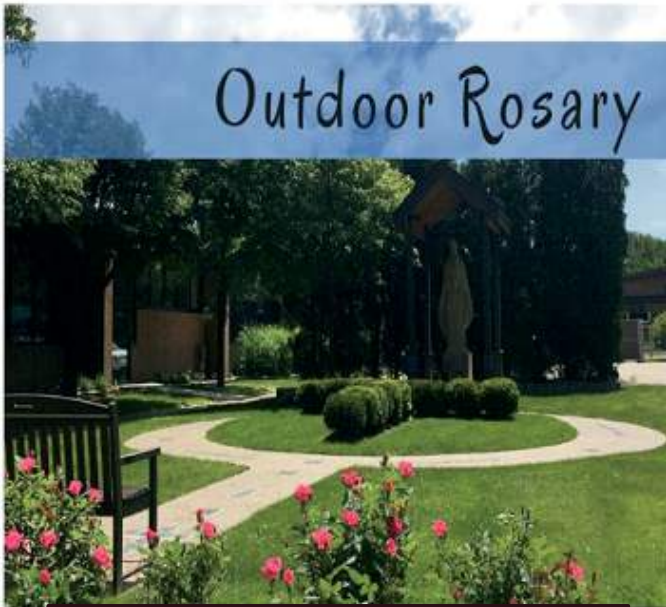
\*\* Please remember your stewardship to the parish during the summer months. Not only do our core ministries continue, but our budget needs are still the same during the summer as they are during the rest of the year. As we approach the "end of the year" at the end of June, we hope to close the budget gap in the Sunday Offerings. If perhaps you can "make up" any past Sundays by the end of this month, it would be greatly appreciated.

\*\* Thank you to all the parishioners who came to one of the "listening sessions." Much information was shared about the need for the restructuring. The facts tell the story. We simply cannot supply enough priests to effectively minister to the 209 parishes we presently have ten years down the road with 100 less priests. That is one reason why we have to move to *pastorates*, i.e., a parish, of a few parishes, independent of each other, though sharing one pastor, and probably an associate or two to minister to the whole pastorate. Think of the restructuring this way. Just as many of you have had to downsize, so too the archdiocese, one time comprising of 1.5 million people to now under 900,000. Continue to pray for the restructuring and an increase in vocations!

\*\* Finally, you don't want to miss "**Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat**" being performed on our own stage this coming Friday and Saturday. The cast is made up of multiple generations of parishioners who have a good time performing. The story is great, the music is lively, the message really hits home. It will leave you smiling!

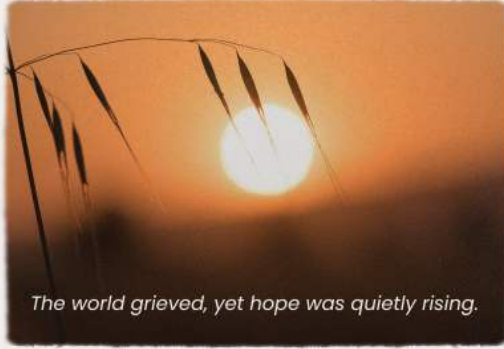

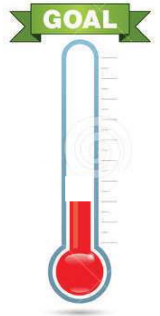
God has blessed each of us with time, talents, and resources meant not to be held back, but shared generously. Through faithful stewardship, we participate directly in the Church’s work of evangelization.
