The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Bride or Groom must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS, for at least 3 months before prep can begin. Bride or Groom need to contact the parish to inquire about wedding prep. Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months prior to your wedding date to start preparations.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Happy Independence Day! The Declaration of Independence was basically a list of the reasons why the 13 colonies had broken ties with their mother country, Great Britain. It was written by a committee headed by Thomas Jefferson. It stated that all people have a right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. By the time the Declaration was produced, the Revolutionary War had already been going on for some months. It would take eight years for the colonists to win the independence they prized so greatly.

Even in the United States, the poor and some minority citizens are often robbed of their basic rights. Frederick Douglass, the great anti-slavery writer, was once asked to give a speech on the Fourth of July. Pointing out that many African Americans were still held as slaves, he told those who had asked him to speak, "The blessings for which you on this day rejoice are not held in common."

Our bright celebrations this day are done in the hope that one day all will be free, that one day the earth itself will shine with liberty.

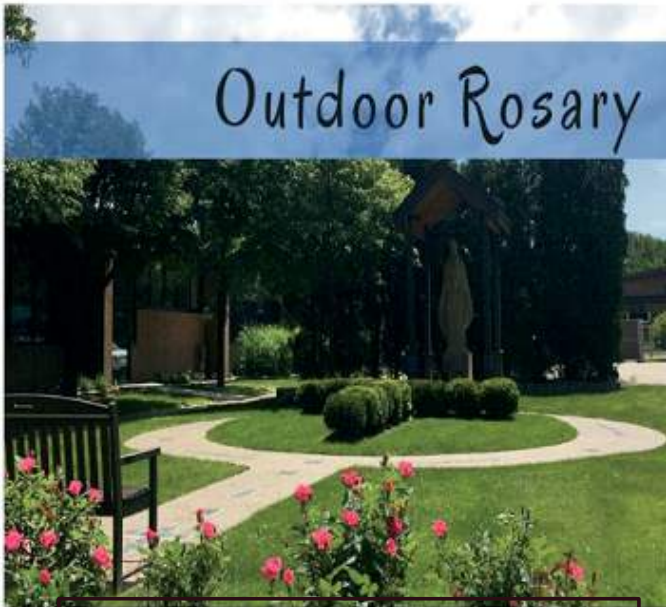

Deo Gratias was founded by two Felician sisters in 2018 and deals primarily with food insecurity in northeast Detroit and Harper Woods – and even supports some guests living in 48236. Our mission is to provide Christ-like hospitality to our guests in both our daily Café and Food Pantry.

In 2025, Deo Gratias served over 30,000 meals in the Café and distributed over 170,000 pounds of food via our Pantry. We also have a social worker that provides referrals for our guest needing additional help, a tutoring program for elementary and middle school students, an art room and a community garden!

We are looking to grow support for our mission. That support could take any number of forms, including:

- donations of cash
- gift cards (for stores like Kroger, Meijer, etc.)
- non-perishable food items
