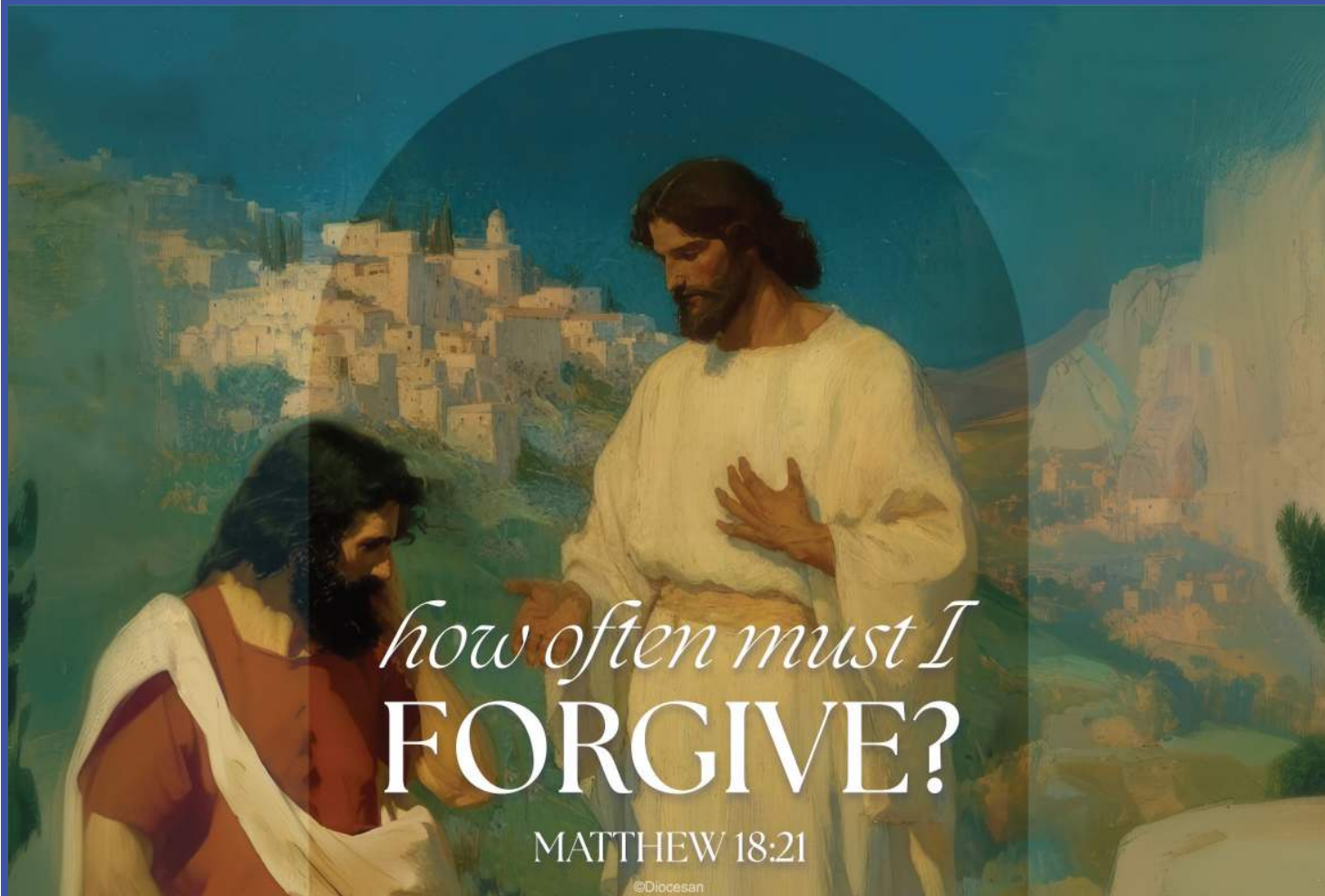

Half and Half

Last week, 185 priests gathered for another installment in the process of our archdiocesan restructuring. Its purpose was to provide implementation support for all the clergy throughout this process.

Here is an update on what has transpired and a look down the road.

We are now in a refinement phase of what was offered this past spring and summer in the first draft of

proposed changes to our parishes. During 412 parish listening sessions, more than 40,000 attended. In these listening sessions, in each of the 15 planning areas, various models were presented pertaining to the more than 200 parishes and how they might be grouped into a new reality call pastorates. A pastorate might one parish, or two or even 4 parishes, under one pastor with other priest associates. After the listening sessions, more than 17,000 people responded to an online survey seeking feedback on the proposals. What a great response to both the listening sessions as well as the surveys.

During these months, various teams and consultative bodies review the feedback regrading the proposed pastorates. In this month, select priests and lay leaders from each of the 15 planning areas will examine all the feedback and look at key themes that have emerged. Revised draft models will then be presented for additional feedback. As stated throughout the process, nothing has been decided already (despite what many people say). After the refinement, taken over these months ahead, a final decision by Archbishop Weisenburger will be made in April of 2027. In all probability, what finally emerges in the pastorates can be 20%-40% different than what was presented during the listening sessions.

We know that dozens of parish sites are expected to no longer offer weekend Masses. It is part of the reality we face given the reality that Mass attendance has fallen about 40% since 2011, and the number of priests in active ministry has also shrunk. In five years there will be about 40 less priests and 100 less priests in ten years. We know the reality of some present parishes no longer having weekend Masses is very difficult, for the parishioners as well as the priests.

Parishioners and priests alike will be experiencing loss and challenges in this process. Hence, the support services offered to the clergy is important. We presently have about 209 pastors. Under the new pastorate model, we will have far less pastors, probably between 60 and 70 pastors. As you can see, more than half of present day pastors, will no longer be the pastor! Many priests of retirement age, presently pastoring a parish, will most likely choose to retire and exercise their priestly ministry assisting other pastorates as needed. However you can see the huge change for many priests going from being the pastor to taking a new role of being the associate pastor in a pastorate. A challenging task indeed in many ways. Some pastors will now have on their "team" priests who might have been a pastor for 20 years or more, now in a supporting role. Not exactly easy for both the new pastor and the new "associate" as well. Hence, the workshops and resources available to us priests on how to navigate the challenges, tensions, disputes, ahead! But we also know there will be abundant graces and blessings that await, as other dioceses who have gone through similar restructuring have attested. With the help of Christ the Good Shepherd, these dioceses have said there is a renewed sense of priestly fraternity and ministry after their restructuring. We certainly hope and pray for that to happen here in our archdiocese.

You see this process has each and every one of us being effected in many ways. Let us continue to pray for each other and be docile to the working of the Holy Spirit.
