1. Opening Prayer (read together)	2. Personal Connection

Parents- Reflect on, then discuss the following: Mankind is created in the image and likeness of God. How does that knowledge affect how you view and treat your body?
I believe these and all the truths which the HOly Catholic Church teaches, Because you have revealed them, Who can neither deceive nor be deceived.	After sharing, ask your student: How can you dress, act, or behave in a way that pays respect to the fact that you are made in the image and likeness of God?

Read Understanding Sin (pg. 71-72)

3. The Catechism for Adults tells us that "sin is not a weakness we can overcome by our own efforts" (pg. 72), so what can we do *or* who can we turn to for help?

4. What brought Alex Jones back to the faith?
