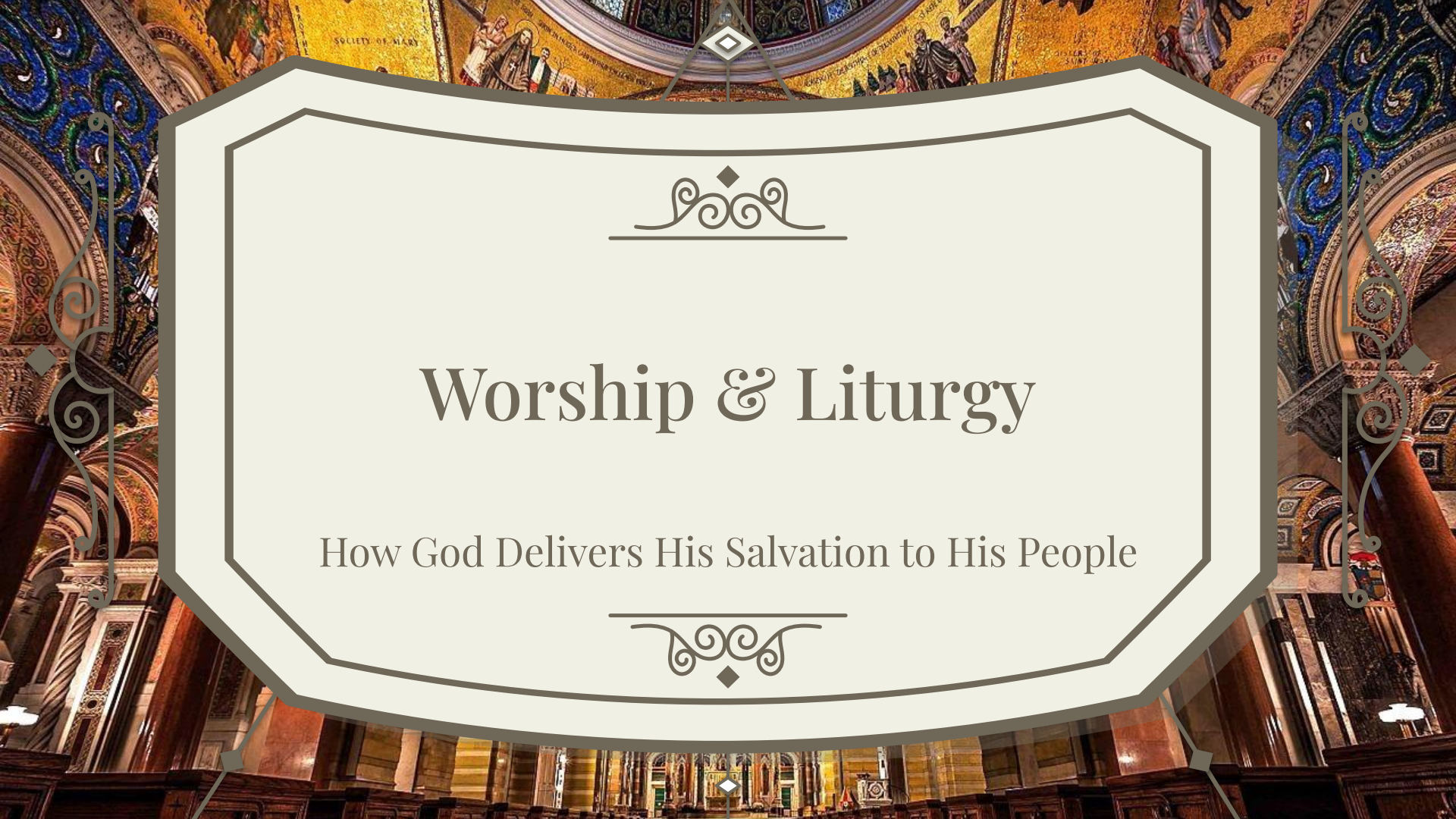
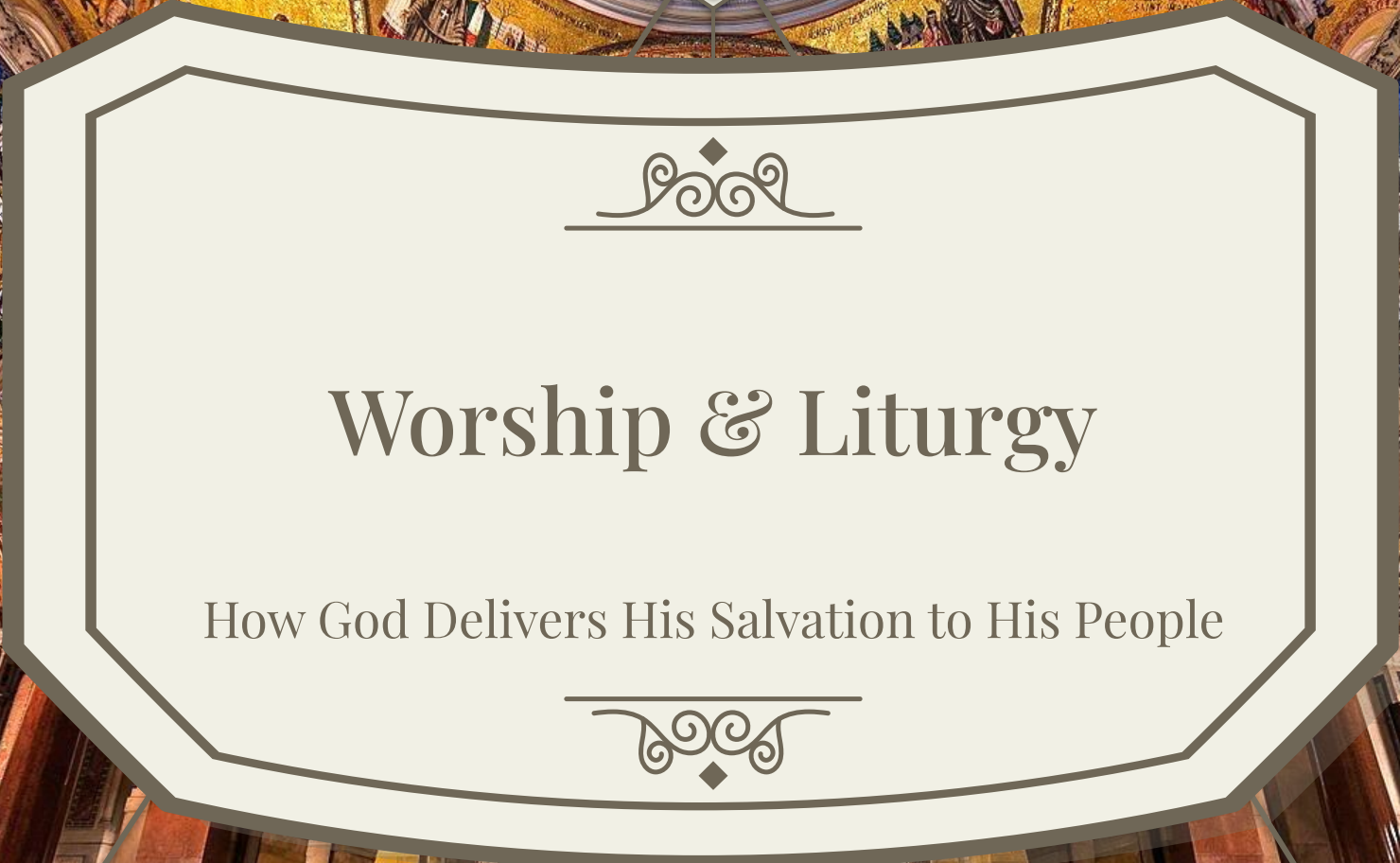

Kingdom: David

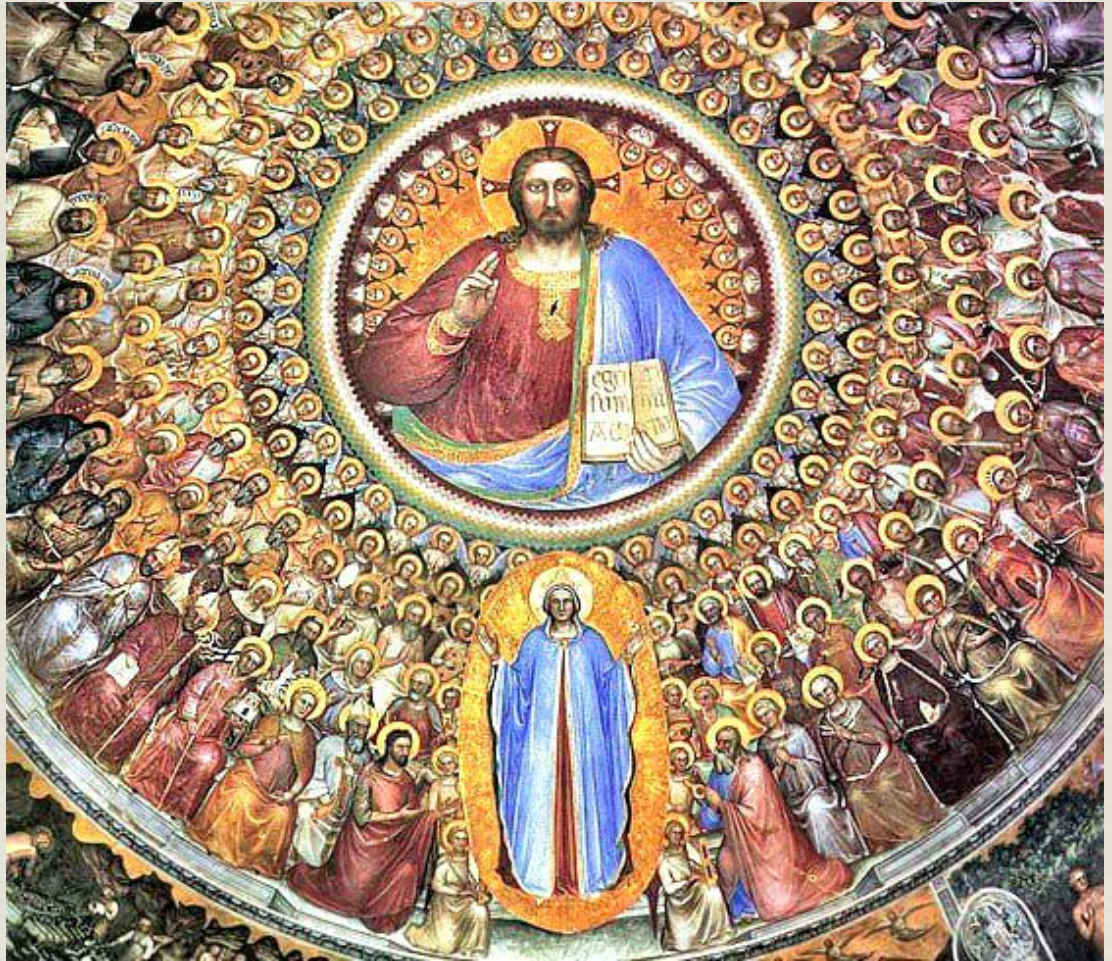

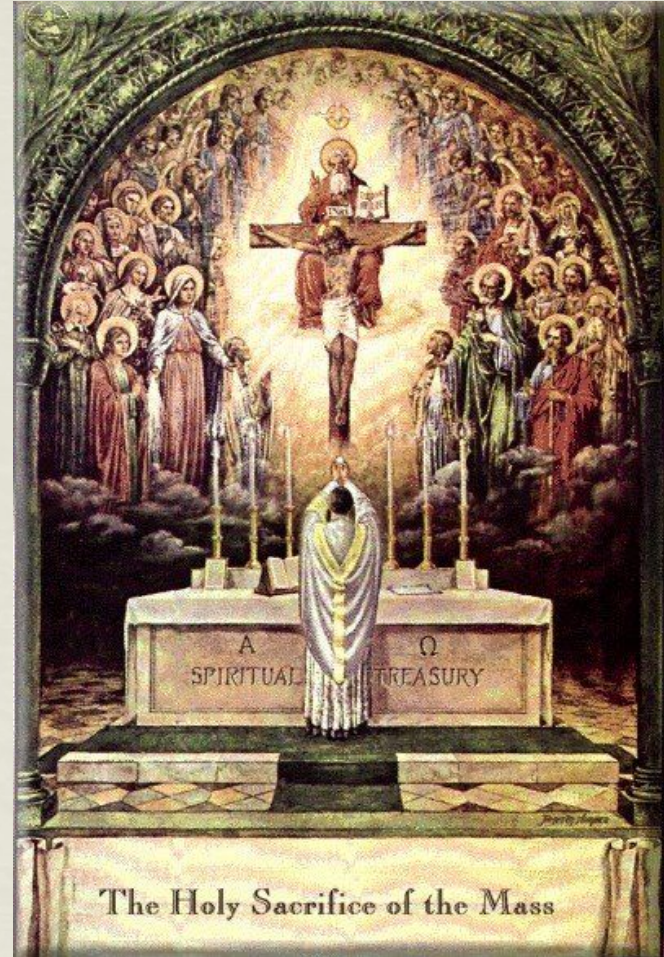
