<u>Intrapersonal</u> – What does this event/issue reveal to me about my priorities, needs, biases, hopes, fears, desires, insecurities and interior disposition?

<u>Interpersonal</u> – What does this event/issue reveal to me about my communication style and my interaction patterns with other people?

<u>Theological</u> – What does this event/issue reveal to me about my understanding and application of the teaching and theology of the Church? What Church teaching, Tradition, or experience have I used to inform my actions in this event and since?
