The following information will help you as you prepare:

1. Participants should be registered by their group leader/chaperone on Eventbrite at this [link](#). Please provide all requested information. If you have any changes to your registration after the deadline but before the event, please get in touch with Youth Ministry immediately at [313-237-5891](tel:313-237-5891).
2. Please note the essential attachments above. Of special note:
 - a. Medical Release Forms (Form B): Each youth and adult participant should fill out the form completely. You should make copies of these forms to submit by **July 18, 2025**, and retain the originals for your use during the event.
 - b. Code of Behavior (Form D): Each youth participant and his/her parent or guardian must sign and return a Code of Behavior form. Adults should be provided with a copy for their information.
3. *Young people from five different grades are welcome.* Participants need to have completed their 8th grade year through entering their freshman year of college. Group size may vary *but there must be a minimum of 2 adults per participating parish, then one adult per five to six youth.*
4. A parent information sheet is attached. Please fill in the requested information and make copies for each participant's family. This sheet contains the packing list. Make copies as needed.
5. Per person cost is \$60.00 (*Scholarships may be available.*)
6. **Deadline for registration: Friday, July 18, 2025.**

What is the Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home?

Pope Francis convoked the Jubilee Year 2025, themed "Pilgrims of Hope," as a time for spiritual renewal and reconciliation. This Jubilee invites people from around the world to walk through the Holy Doors of Rome's major basilicas, seek plenary indulgences, and embrace a new beginning rooted in the transformative power of God's Kingdom. Despite Pope Francis's passing in April 2025, the Jubilee continues as planned, honoring his vision of a Church that reaches out to the margins and opens its doors to all. As an Archdiocese, we will gather on a two-day event to unite and celebrate the jubilee with the universal church.

Pilgrims?

A pilgrim is someone on a spiritual journey. "It is a spiritual journey, a time to reconnect with Jesus, a time to share your faith, a time to renew your commitment to Christ. It literally can be a life-changing, exciting and awesome event!" It is so much more than a vacation, a camping trip, and even a retreat!

What do you do at a Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home?

At the Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home, we will have activities, a pilgrimage tour at the Blessed Cathedral of the Most Blessed Sacrament and Solanus Casey Center, Liturgy, talks, prayer, meals, Movie night, veneration of relics and more all while meeting other youth from all over the Archdiocese of Detroit, getting to know those you already know better, and growing deeper in your faith!

Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home 2025: Information for Parish Group Leaders

- The cost of registration is \$60 for all participants.
- This event will include opportunities for high school-aged youth and their chaperones *only*.
- Chaperones must be 21 years old or older and have had a background check, along with being PGC certified and have signed the code of conduct.
- Youth are those teens entering 9th grade through those who have just completed 12th grade.
- Saturday's lunch, dinner, an evening snack, and Sunday's breakfast will be provided.
- Sleeping will take place outside without tents or shelters (weather permitting) in solidarity with pilgrims abroad in Rome who will be doing the same.
- A prayer journal (Jubilee Passport) will be provided to each participant.
- The **adult role** at Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home is very important. As adults, we are at the event to share with our youth the experience of celebrating the gift of our faith. We are their guides, their supporters, their encouragers, as well as their chaperones. We have a responsibility to the youth, as well as to ourselves, to ensure that the Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home experience is one of learning, growth and celebration.

This release of indemnification does not apply to claims for intentional misconduct or gross negligence, nor does this release or indemnification apply to the extent of commercial insurance coverage for any claim, but this Release or Indemnification shall apply to the extent of any self-insurance or deductible applicable to any claim.

Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home Code of Behavior

We are happy and excited that you are joining us as part of the **AOD Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home**. The *Code of Behavior* has been developed as a way of helping participants understand what is expected of them during the event and of making the experience a healthy and spiritual one for all involved. Please read through the *Code* carefully, as you will be expected to honor and uphold it throughout your time with us.

- As necessary as rules are to maintain order, they can't and won't guarantee a successful **AOD Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home** experience. Success depends on people's willingness to work together for the common good.
- Participants take part in **AOD Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home** as part of a parish or school team. The on-site adult leader of each team maintains primary responsibility for the actions of his or her team members. If damage occurs, the parish or school group is responsible, and the families of team members assume responsibility for any damages done to the hosting facilities.
- Participants are expected to attend all sessions and events unless explicitly excused by the Program Director(s).
- You must wear your lanyard with your Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home Credentials, your Jubilee passport and medical release at all times.
- Dress throughout the **AOD Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home** experience is casual; however, shirts and shoes must be worn at all sessions and meals.
- Socializing should take place only in the designated public areas of the housing facility. No visiting is allowed in sleeping areas occupied by the opposite sex.
- Each day will be a busy one - making adequate sleep a necessity. Participants must be in their respective areas by curfew time. The noise level in the sleeping areas should be kept at a minimum. Scheduled quiet and silent times must be honored. Only the Program Director can alter curfew times or the timing of any other scheduled activity.
- Smoking is not allowed during scheduled group activities. All other local smoking restrictions must be honored (ages, locations, times, etc.).
- The purchase, possession or consumption of alcohol or drugs by participants will result in immediate dismissal from the program. Major infractions of the *Code of Behavior* will meet with the same consequences.

Parent or Guardian: I agree that my child shall abide by the rules and regulations outlined in the **AOD Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home** *Code of Behavior*. I have reviewed it and discussed the *Code* with my child prior to signing this form. I agree that if my child fails to consistently abide by the *Code* or engages in a serious infraction of the *Code*, he or she may be immediately dismissed from the **AOD Jubilee of Hope Overnight at Home** program and sent home at my expense.
