### Enjoy Spring Break!

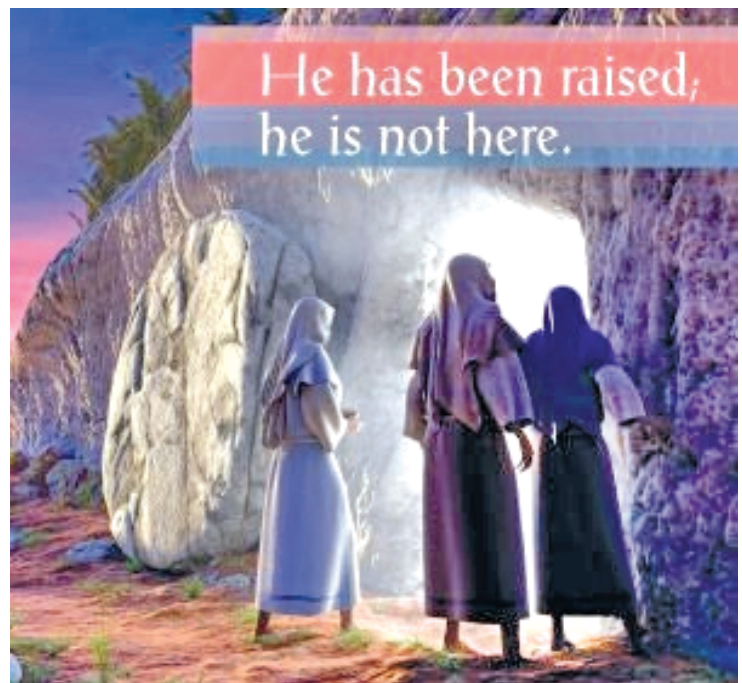
