ANOIDING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Good and Bad Habits in the Church

In the 2017 Pastoral Letter, "Unleash the Gospel," Archbishop Allen Vigneron points out "Good and Bad Habits" of Church life, which describe things that should change in parish life as well as the great things the Church can become! We will go through one per week. Let's ask Our Lord for a change of heart, to drop any bad habits and replace them with what He would have us be!

Bad — Status-Quo Mentality

Pope Francis has implored the Church: "Be bold and creative!" Parishes and the Church as a whole can get caught up in a "Status-Quo Mentality," which simply says, "We have always done it this way...why change? We are 'good enough.'" But Our Lord doesn't want us doing things simply because we feel like "This is the way it's always been." Stuck in that mentality, we never grow. We can never be bold and creative as the Holy Father asks us to be. We have to continue to spread the Good News of what Jesus has done for us, and we have to do it in an ever-changing age. This is going to require getting out of our comfort zones...but that is okay! Because of last week's *Good Habit*, "Confidence in God," we can be sure that Our Lord will guide us through these different times, just as He walked with Peter on the water.

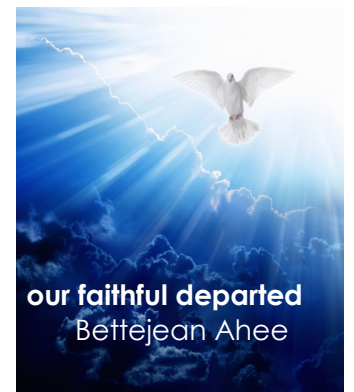
