The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.



Examine the features and expressions on the Holy Family, the shepherds and kings. Imagine your own expression if you were there! Imagine the wonder and awe of what this little child can do for your life!! As you look at this scene, pray this little prayer:

Lord, we pray before this Christmas crib, and await the feast of the birth of the Holy Child. Call forth the child from within each of us; cause us to wonder and to rejoice again in this most ancient feast. With the shepherds we come to the birth of Christ, seeking a simple celebration. The greatest gift will be ourselves given to you, Our God, and to each other. May the star of Bethlehem, which shone brightly over the first crib, stand guard over us filling us and all the earth with light and peace.

- ** There are at least three opportunities this week to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (individual Confession). The first is Monday 6 8 pm and the second is Tuesday, 2 4 pm. You will find a number of our local parishes in the SERF Vicariate having the same schedule as we "keep the light on" just for you. I will also be available for private confessions this Thursday, Dec. 16 from 1 until 2 pm in church Please take the opportunity to experience this Grace-filled Sacrament and make straight the highway for our Lord.
- ** A reminder to please try and be on time for the start of Mass. Many people still seem to be coming 5, 10 even 20 minutes late. Leaving the house a few minutes earlier should do the trick.
- ** Our Knights of Columbus Council need all your orders for the honey glazed, spiral sliced, hams to be placed by Wednesday Dec. 15, for pick up on Wednesday, Dec. 22. Thanks for your support on the hams, supporting our Knights, and all that you do for the parish.



Musical Musings – Kyrie eleison / Lord, have mercy, / For you, O Lord...

I am writing these musings from Portland, Oregon, where I am singing with the professional chamber choir, Cappella Romana in the west coast premiere of Benedict Sheehan's setting of the *Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom* under the direction of the composer. A couple of summers ago – pre-pandemic – this work was recorded by his St. Tikhon's Choir, a project which I had the privilege of being a part of, and most recently the recording was named a finalist in the 2022 Grammy awards. The liturgy of St. John Chrysostom is the Orthodox equivalent of the Holy Mass, the very summit of Church's worship and sacrifice. (The full recording is available on YouTube, you'll find it simply by doing a search for Benedict Sheehan, Liturgy of St John Chrysostom; I highly recommend listening and praying it this Advent season.)

Two central features of the Liturgy are the many times the words, "Lord, have mercy," or its Greek translation, "Kyrie eleison" is chanted, (a text we sing at the beginning of Mass) and also the extensive litanies that are prayed. A litany is a prayer consisting of a series of invocations and supplications by the leader with responses repeated by the congregation, an example of which is the Litany of the Saints. With the tragic events that unfolded locally in Oxford, singing these litanies in concert here in the Pacific Northwest and in the liturgy in prayer certainly took on deeper resonance, as did the beautiful hymn we have been singing during this season during communion which itself is a litany:

For you, O Lord, my soul in stillness waits, Truly my hope is in you.

O Lord of Light, our only hope of glory, Your radiance shines in all who look to you, Come, light the hearts of all in dark and shadow.

O Spring of Joy, rain down upon our spirits, Our thirsty hearts are yearning for your Word, Come, make us whole, be comfort to our hearts.

O Root of Life, implant your seed within us, And in your advent draw us all to you, Our hope reborn in dying and in rising.

O Key of Knowledge, guide us in our pilgrimage, We ever seek, yet unfulfilled remain, Open to us the pathway of your peace.

With this in mind, about our closing organ voluntary this weekend, a piece simply titled, *Litanies*, its composer, Jehan Alain, writes: "When the Christian soul in its distress finds no new words with which to implore God's mercy, it repeats endlessly the same invocation with strong faith. Reason having attained its zenith, Faith alone reaches on high." Alain wrote about playing this piece. "Prayer is not a lament but a devastating tornado, flattening everything in its way. It is also an obsession. You must fill people's ears with it, and God's ears too"

Lord, have mercy. Lord, hear our prayer.


